The Boone County Clerk's Office is in need of election workers to staff polling places for elections. In order to serve, you must be a registered voter in Boone County. The work day begins at 5:00 a.m. and ends after the polls close at 7:00 p.m. on election night.

The base pay rate is \$120.00 for the day and you will also need to attend paid training. Supervisors can earn up to \$197.00.

TWO NEW LAWS IN EFFECT FOR POLL WORKERS:

- Employers must let you off work (like jury duty only better pay) if you notify them at least 7 days prior to an election.
