SUBJECT: Reduce Speed Limit on Old No. 7

Acting Public Works Director Frank Abart stated due to service improvements on this road, it is recommended the speed limit be reduced from 35 miles per hour to 30 miles per hour.

In response to a question from Commissioner Vogt, Mr. Abart replied the curves and nature of the road warrant the reduced speed limit. There are a lot of houses in the area. Traffic is local.

Commissioner Vogt moved that the County Commission of the County of Boone reduce the speed limit on Old No. 7 from Route VV to the end of the existing pavement from 35 miles per hour to 30 miles per hour.

Commissioner Miller seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. **Order 643-95.**

SUBJECT: Lease of County Property to Diamond Council

Mr. Patton stated the lease is for a fifteen year term with three, five year renewal options. Improvements constructed on the property become the property of the county at the end of the initial term or renewal terms. Use of the property is restricted. Motorized sport vehicles are not allowed. The lease allows them to take possession today.

Commissioner Miller moved that the County Commission of the County of Boone approve, and authorize District II Commissioner Linda Vogt to sign, the attached lease of county property by the Columbia Diamond Council, Inc. The property is described in the lease as Tract A of survey recorded at Book 1196 Page 466 of the Survey Records of Boone County, Missouri.

Commissioner Vogt seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. **Order 644-95.**
