In that the attached petitions meet the requirements set forth in section 67.457.3 RSMo. and Commission Order #424-91 for the formation of neighborhood improvement districts, the county Commission hereby approves the advisability of the improvement and orders the establishment of the **Cedar Gate Neighborhood Improvement District** to be described as follows:

**A tract of land recorded by General Warranty Deed recorded in Book 869, Page 389, as shown and described in a survey recorded in Book 392, Page 947, Records of Boone County, Missouri.**

Lots 1 thru 4, as recorded in Plat Book 10, Page 158, Cedar Gates Estates, Records of Boone County, Missouri.

Lots 7, 8, 13 & 14, as recorded in Plat Book 11, Page 151, Cedar Gates Estates, Records of Boone County, Missouri.

Lots 5, 6, 9, 10, 11, 12, 15, 16, 17, 18, 21, 22, 23, 24, 26, 27, 28, 29 & 32, as recorded in Plat Book 11, Page 311, Cedar Gates Estates, Block III, Records of Boone County, Missouri.

The final cost of the improvement shall not exceed the estimated cost of **\$153,779.00** by more than twenty-five percent (25%). The County Commission hereby orders the County Public Works Director to make plans and specifications for the proposed project and file said plans and specifications with the County Clerk of Boone County, Missouri.

The Commission further **orders** that the improvement costs shall be assessed equally against each parcel described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and shall be payable in not more than ten (10) substantially equal annual installments in accordance with the laws of the State of Missouri and consistent with the administrative policies of the County of Boone, and the clerk shall prepare an assessment list and notify the property owners of a public hearing on the proposed improvement.
