Dear Commissioners Elkin, Miller and Stamper,

As you know, last February you formally approved the Boone County Planning and Zoning Commission's involvement in efforts to establish a coordinated process for the Gans Creek watershed area with the Columbia Planning and Zoning Commission. You probably also know that our efforts were thwarted by the failure of the Columbia City Council to follow your lead and authorize the

city's planning and zoning commissioners to join us. Though that initiative appears to have failed, we remain undaunted.

The two commissions are still very committed to working together to develop a practical and defensible model for joint a land-use planning in the urban fringe. It is clear to me, through your actions and Commissioner Stamper's participation in our last joint meeting, Oct. 19, that you support these efforts. At that meeting, the joint P&Z commissioners voted unanimously to send to both their decision-making bodies a resolution that would authorize their continued efforts.

Therefore, I would ask that you consider and act upon the following resolution:

We request from Boone County Commission a resolution of understanding that authorizes the two commissions (Columbia Planning & Zoning Commission, Boone County Planning & Zoning Commission) to draft a resolution that will propose how the Columbia and Boone County planning and zoning commissions deal with issues of mutual concern in the urban fringe area.

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
