Commissioner Stamper moved that the County Commission of the County of Boone call for an election to be held in said County on Tuesday, the 4th day of April, 1995, for the purpose of electing two (2) members of the County Hospital Board of Trustees. One trustee shall be elected for a four-year term and one trustee shall be elected for a three-year term. Pursuant to the provisions of 205.170 RSMo. (1994) the terms of the two (2) trustees elected at the April 4, 1995 election shall be determined by lot.
