The meeting was called to order at 1:30 p.m.

1. Public Hearing for Proposed Revision to Subdivision Regulations

Mr. Stan Shawver, Director of Planning and Building Inspection was present on behalf of this item.

Mr. Shawver reported there was a section of the Subdivision Regulations that is causing an issue with one of the water districts. In 2000 the County was running into problems with subdivision plats, discovering easements had been recorded that caused conflict with easements coming onto the plat that were being required. A revision was made to the Subdivisions Regulations stating you could not have an easement on a plat that was not defined and were not where Planning and Zoning had marked them.

By adding the word "Exclusive" it would allow the easements to exist and to share, which should take care of the problem.

Commissioner Schnarre opened up for public comment.

Seeing none, he closed the public hearing.

Commissioner Elkin moved now on this day the County Commission of the County of Boone does hereby adopt the revision to the subdivision regulations section 1.5.10 Prohibited Encumbrances.

A. Second Reading Proposal for Consultant Services Boone Industrial Park Phase II

They are developing a more organized and discipline strategy for the documents. They have worked with IT on a prototype and pulled sample documents. From that information they will see what needs to be worked on.
