Public Works

1. 2009 Revenue Sharing Contracts

Commissioner Pearson stated these are contracts with the various cities.

Commissioner Miller moved on this day the County Commission of the County of Boone does hereby approve the 2009 Revenue Sharing Contracts with the following entities:

City of Ashland: \$60,000 City of Centralia: \$80,000

Centralia Special Road District: \$87,500

City of Columbia: \$300,000 City of Hallsville: \$60,000 City of Harrisburg: \$31,314 City of Hartsburg: \$17,000

City of Pierpont: \$2,500 (snow removal only)

City of Rocheport: \$35,500 City of Sturgeon: \$31,250

It is further ordered the Presiding Commissioner is hereby authorized to sign said contracts.

Commissioner Elkin seconded the motion.

Commissioner Pearson stated when we passed the ½ cent sales tax for roads, one of the agreements that we have with the cities that participate in this is revenue replacement for the revenue that is lost in the common roads. He stated we also agreed that we would do revenue sharing by projects, and that is what this part is. Each city identifies things they would like to do and we do our best to accommodate those requests.

2. City of Sturgeon Revenue Sharing Reallocation

Commissioner Elkin stated the chip and seal process creates a lot of dust, so Sturgeon wants to do micro surfacing, and they are able to do more linear footage of road this way. This is basically to allow them to reallocate the revenue sharing funds to do this.

Commissioner Elkin moved on this day the County Commission of the County of Boone does hereby approve the 2008 Revenue Sharing reallocation of funds for the City of Sturgeon:

Reallocation of \$26,099.00 from chip seal and asphalt on West Francis, North Rochford, North Ruby and Proctor Street to Micro Surfacing on West Francis, West Stone, West Harris, West Smith, North Fairgrounds, North Ogden and North Ruby.

3. 69-30DEC08 – Fire Extinguisher Inspection and Maintenance Term and Supply (first reading)

Ms. Bobbitt stated the bid for Fire Extinguisher Inspection and Maintenance Term and Supply closed on December 30, 2008. Five bids were received. The bid evaluation was based upon where the bulk of our usage is: Annual Maintenance, 6-Year Maintenance, and Hydrotesting Maintenance of ABC. Upon completion of the bid evaluation, Facilities Maintenance recommends award to Jeff City Fire Specialists for offering the lowest and best bid for Boone County.

The contract period is January 1, 2009, through December 31, 2009, with four, one year renewals. Term and supply invoices will be paid from Department 6100 – Facilities and Grounds Maintenance, Account 71100 – Outside Services. \$5,480.00 was budgeted for 2009.
