The bid for 35 Ton Detachable Gooseneck Trailer closed on May 14, 2012. Four bids were received. Purchasing and the Boone County Public Works Department recommend award to Utility Trailer Co. for offering the best bid for Boone County.

One 35 Ton Interstate – 70SDGN-AR Trailer will be purchased on this contract. The total cost for this item and optional equipment is \$43,717.00 and will be paid from department 2040 – PW Maintenance Operations, account 92300 – Replacement Machines and Equipment. \$186,197.97 is left in this account for 2012.
