Effective date of promotion of Cheri Sapp, Lead Deputy Collector, to Chief Deputy Collector is January 28, 2008

Last working day of Donna Anderson, Chief Deputy Collector, is February 22, 2008

There are 160 work hours between January 28, 2008 and February 22, 2008

Commission Order 147-2005 requires approval of a training period for anything in excess of 80 hours

The current hourly salary of the Lead Deputy is \$16.78; the new salary will be \$19.00 for a difference of \$2.22/hour

Salary \$177.60 (80hrs @ 2.22)
FICA \$13.59 (177.60 * .0765)
Workers Comp. \$.76 (177.60 * .0043)
Disability \$.66 (177.60 * .0037)

Total \$192.61

Total for the full 160 hours will be \$385.22 difference

There may be no shortfall to cover by year end because: 1). the length of time it will take to advertise, interview, select, conduct the background and reference checks, hire and bring aboard the replacment employee in the Lead Deputy Collector position; and 2). the salary of the new Chief Deputy is less than the retiring Chief Deputy.





Two-Week Training Period for New Employees

The Personnel Advisory Committee resolved that there should be a training period of up to two weeks (80 hours) allowed for new employees. This allows the Administrative Authority to hire a new employee while still employing the old employee (for training purposes) for a period not to exceed two (2) weeks (80 hours)

Anything in excess of 80 hours requires Commission approval.

This provision is granted to all departments regardless of whether there is excess budget available. It is assumed that any shortfall realized from exercising this provision will be made up from the emergency fund.
