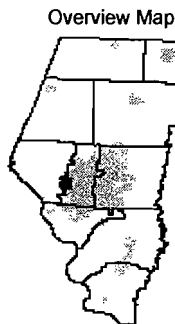
Boone County Internet Tax Parcel Map

ADDENDUM TO LEGAL SERVICES COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, Boone County Group Homes and Family Support, now known as Boone County Family Resources (BCFR), and Boone County, Missouri have entered into a Legal Services Cooperative Agreement dated March 12, 2002; and

WHEREAS, Boone County and BCFR desire to continue under a Legal Services Cooperative Agreement; and


WHEREAS, for the ease of budgeting and record administration of both parties, the parties desire to enter into an Addendum to said agreement addressing a modification of the payment provisions.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED TO BY AND BETWEEN PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

1. BCFR will remit to Boone County the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) per month as and for general legal services provided under the Cooperative Agreement.
2. Whenever, it appears that the legal services required would exceed three (3) hours per month on the part of the County Counselor then, upon mutual agreement of the County Counselor and the Executive Director of BCFR, the parties will track time for that particular project and BCFR will reimburse the County for legal services at the hourly rate set forth in the Agreement.
3. All other provisions of the Legal Service Cooperative Agreement regarding billing, reimbursement of expenses and other provisions not expressly changed by this Addendum shall remain in full force and effect.





WHEREAS, for the ease of budgeting and record administration of both parties, the parties desire to enter into an Addendum to said agreement addressing a modification of the payment provisions.


