

**FINDING OF PUBLIC NUISANCE AND ORDER FOR ABATEMENT**

**NOW** on this 16<sup>th</sup> day of November 2010, the County Commission of Boone County, Missouri met in regular session and entered the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and order for abatement of nuisance:

**Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law**

The County Commission finds as fact and concludes as a matter of law the following:

1. The Boone County Code of Health Regulations (the "Code") are officially noticed and are made a part of the record in this proceeding.
2. The City of Columbia/Boone County Health Department administrative record is made a part of the record in this proceeding and incorporated herein by reference. In addition, any live testimony of the official(s) of the department and other interested persons are made a part of the record in this proceeding.
3. A public nuisance exists described as follows: weeds in excess of twelve inches high
4. The location of the public nuisance is as follows: 332 E. Winter Street, Columbia, MO, a/k/a parcel# 11-619-24-01-102.00 01, Section 24, Township 49, Range 13 as shown in deed book 1078 page 0219, Boone County
5. The specific violation of the Code is: growth of weeds in excess of twelve inches high in violation of section 6.7 of the Code
6. The Health Director's designated Health Official made the above determination of the existence of the public nuisance at the above location. Notice of that determination and the requirement for abatement was given in accordance with section 6.10.1 of the Code on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of October 2010, to the property owner, occupant, and any other applicable interested persons.
7. The above described public nuisance was not abated. As required by section 6.10.2 of the Code, the property owner, occupant, and any other applicable interested persons were given notice of the hearing conducted this date before the Boone County Commission for an order to abate the above nuisance at government expense with the cost and expense thereof to be charged against the above described property as a special tax bill and added to the real estate taxes for said property for the current year.
8. No credible evidence has been presented at the hearing to demonstrate that no public nuisance exists or that abatement has been performed or is unnecessary; accordingly, in accordance with section 6.10.2 of the Code and section 67.402, RSMo, the County

Commission finds and determines from the credible evidence presented that a public nuisance exists at the above location which requires abatement and that the parties responsible for abating such nuisance have failed to do so as required by the Health Director or Official's original order referred to above.


**Order For Abatement Chargeable As a Special Assessment To The Property**

Based upon the foregoing, the County Commission hereby orders abatement of the above described public nuisance at public expense and the Health Director is hereby authorized and directed to carry out this order.



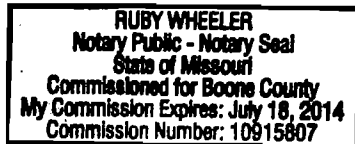

Digital Intelligence is the sole source provider for the FRED family of forensic computers and their forensic software suite (see attached letter from Digital Intelligence). According to the Sheriff's Office, these computers must be compatible with FTK forensic software 3.1 which is what the Cyber Task Force is currently licensed and trained to use.

The intent to purchase these computers from Digital Intelligence was advertised in the Missourian newspaper on October 4 and the Columbia Daily Tribune on October 5.

Total cost of contract for forensic computers is \$20,698.00 and invoices will be paid from department 2972 – Cyber Crimes Task Force, account 91301 – Computer Hardware.
