

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



The Bid for Fairgrounds Road Asphalt Overlay, 2011 Pavement Preservation closed on March 24, 2011. Three bids were received. Purchasing and the Planning and Building department recommend award to Frech Paving Co. for offering the lowest and best bid for Boone County.

The Bid Amount for this project was \$72,005.95. After including a 5% contingency amount of \$3,600.30 this project has a Purchase Order total of \$75,606.25. Invoices from this contract will be paid from department 2041 – PW – Pavement Preservation, account 71100 – Outside Services. The engineer's estimated amount was \$88,115.00.

**PURCHASE AGREEMENT  
FOR  
UNIFORMS TAILORING – TERM & SUPPLY**

**THIS AGREEMENT** dated the 5<sup>th</sup> day of APRIL 2011 is made between Boone County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri through the Boone County Commission, herein “County” and **Sew Many Dreams**, herein “Contractor.”

**IN CONSIDERATION** of the parties performance of the respective obligations contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

**1. Contract Documents** - This agreement shall consist of this Purchase Agreement for **Uniform Tailoring Term & Supply**, County of Boone Request for Bid for **Uniforms Tailoring Term & Supply**, bid number **04-15MAR11**, Introduction and General Conditions of Bidding, Primary Specifications, Response Presentation and Review, any applicable addenda, the unexecuted Response Form, Standard Terms and Conditions, as well as the Contractor’s bid response dated **March 14, 2011** and executed by **Rebecca Miller** on behalf of the Contractor. All such documents shall constitute the contract documents which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Service or product data, specification and literature submitted with bid response may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office bid file for this bid if not attached. In the event of conflict between any of the foregoing documents, the Introduction and General Conditions of Bidding, this Purchases Agreement. the Primary Specifications, Response Presentation and Review, the unexecuted Response Form, Standard Terms and Conditions, and applicable Addenda shall prevail and control over the Contractor’s bid response.

**2. Contract Duration** - This agreement shall commence on **April 1, 2011 and extend through March 31, 2012** subject to the provisions for termination specified below. This agreement may be extended beyond the expiration date by order of the County for **three (3) additional one-year periods** subject to the pricing clauses in the Contractor’s bid response and thereafter on a month to month basis for a maximum of six (6) months in the event the County is unable to re-bid and/or award a new contract prior to the expiration date after exercising diligent efforts to do so or not.

**3. Basic Services** - The County agrees to purchase from the Contractor and the Contractor agrees to supply the County with **Uniform Tailoring**. Items/service will be provided as required in the bid specifications and in conformity with the contract documents for the prices set forth in the Contractor’s bid response, as needed and as ordered by County.

**4. Delivery** - Contractor agrees to provide the items and service as specified and as agreed to in the bid specifications.

**5. Billing and Payment** - All billing shall be invoiced to Boone County Sheriff Department, 2121 County Dr. Columbia, MO 65202. Billings may only include the prices listed in the Contractor’s bid response. No additional fees for delivery or extra services not included in the bid response or taxes shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in the Contractor’s bid response to the specifications. The County agrees to pay all correct monthly statements within thirty days of receipt, all monthly statements must also have copies of applicable invoices; Contractor agrees to honor any cash or prompt payment discounts offered in its bid response if county makes payment as provided therein. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount; in the event the billing dispute is resolved in favor of the Contractor, the County agrees to pay interest at a rate of 9% per annum on disputed amounts withheld commencing from the last date that payment was due.

6. **Binding Effect** - This agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this agreement remains in full force and effect.

7. **Entire Agreement** - This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior negotiations, written or verbal, and any other bid or bid specification or contractual agreement. This agreement may only be amended by a signed writing executed with the same formality as this agreement.

8. **Termination** - This agreement may be terminated by the County upon thirty days advance written notice for any of the following reasons or under any of the following circumstances:

- a. County may terminate this agreement due to material breach of any term or condition of this agreement, or
- b. County may terminate this agreement if in the opinion of the Boone County Commission if delivery of products are delayed or products delivered are not in conformity with bidding specifications or variances authorized by County, or
- c. If appropriations are not made available and budgeted for any calendar year.
