Liberty Lane – Speed Limit Recommendation

Boone County Public Works recommends setting the speed limit for Liberty Lane from Route M to the Ashland City limits to 45 miles per hour. Liberty Lane from Route M to Palis Nichols Road has been recently reconstructed from gravel to asphalt according to design standards. The section from Palis Nichols to the City limits was paved-in-place in 1999 and is fairly straight. The speed limit for that section was conservatively set at 35 miles per hour when it was paved. The default speed limit for asphalt pavement is 40 miles per hour. The ludy was done to determine the speed limit for the road based on the 85th percentile.

The speed study was conducted on October 20 and 21 on Liberty Lane. Construction was substantially complete and the barricades had been removed. Vehicle speeds were monitored at four locations using a Nu-Metric Traffic Analyzer. The Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, Section 2.B.11 recommends that the posted speed limit should be based on the 85th percentile speed. The 85th percentile speeds at the study locations are as follows:

Location	East Bound	West Bound
East of Route M	43 mph	43 mph
West of Palis Nichols Road	49 mph	44 mph
East of Palis Nichols Road	40 mph	44 mph
West of City Limits	49 mph	46 mph

The average of the 85th percentile speeds is 45 miles per hour, therefore the department recommends posting Liberty Lane at 45 miles per hour. The department also recommends that the 4-way stop at the intersection of Palis Nichols Road and Liberty Lane remain because the pavement profile in the intersection is too abrupt for high speed travel in the predominately traveled east-west direction. If the intersection pavement is ever reprofiled then removal of the east-west stop could be considered.
