BOONE COUNTY OPENINGS FOR CITY/COUNTY BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

BOONE COUNTY BUILDING CODE COMMISSION

Four-member Board and one Voting County Commissioner. The Board is appointed by the County Commission to advise them on matters pertaining to the building code. The Building Code Commission meets on a periodic basis (as needed) to review code issues and review revisions to the model code. Prior to recommending the adoption of any code revisions to the County Commission, the Building Code Commission conducts three public hearings to provide an opportunity for citizen input. Meetings are held at the Boone County Government Center Chambers as needed. (Term – 2 years) One Vacancy; term expires 7/31/2027 or 2 years from appointment.

BOARD OF HEALTH

Four County appointees. The Board meets on the second Thursday of each month at 5:30 PM. at the Health Department. The Board acts as an advisory board to the County Commission and the Health Director on matters involving public health and animal control. (**Term – 3 years**) **One Vacancy**; term expires 09/01/2028, or 3 years from appointment.

BOONE COUNTY REGIONAL SEWER DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Five-member Board, including one County Commissioner. Meetings are held the third Tuesday of each month at 5:30 p.m. in the Boone County Commission Chambers. The Board is to assume long range responsibility for wastewater quality within Boone County, except for those facilities operated by a municipality, in order to improve and maintain the health and welfare of the residents of the County. Five trustees shall be appointed, the majority of whom shall reside within the boundaries of the district. RSMo. 204.300 (**Term - 5 years**) **One**Vacancy; term expires 09/01/2030, or 5 years from appointment.

FOOD COUNCIL

Two County appointees to an eleven-member board created by Columbia city ordinances, Sec. 2-301 through Sec. 2-315. The board advises the Columbia city council in matters pertaining to food systems and food policies that impact the nutritional health of community residents and visitors. (**Term - 3 years**) **Two Vacancies** One of the County appointees would serve for one (1) year, and the second County appointee would serve for two (2) years as their initial terms. Thereafter, board appointees would have 3-year terms.
