Health Department

- 1. 1st & 2nd reading; Abatement of a property located at 4869 Hwy. HH, parcel #12-204-10-07-002.00 01**

Britni Hendren said she received a complaint on August 22nd about three vehicles in the owner's driveway. The owner did call us yesterday and is here today. He is requesting an extension to take care of these vehicles. There are three vehicles, one is on blocks, one has a flat tire and no plates and the 3rd vehicle has been taken care of satisfactorily.

Commissioner Atwill asked if the property owner would like to speak on this abatement.

Mauricio Duran said he is the owner and needs some additional time take care of these vehicles.

Commissioner Atwill said that is good news. In these instances, we will go ahead with the order and if this is taken care to the satisfaction of the Health Department, in a timely fashion, the order will not be enforced.

2. First reading; Chariton County Prisoner/Inmate Boarding Agreement

Commissioner Miller said the \$35 per day is a very cheap price for the boarding and handling of inmates.

Commissioner Atwill asked if this is a new facility.

Commissioner Thompson said it is not new, but newer. It is one of the better places around to house inmates.

3. Second reading; Approve Job Classification recommendation to create Radio Technician I and II classifications (1st read 10-6-16)

Commissioner Thompson moved on this day the County Commission of the County of Boone does hereby approve the following recommendation from the Job Classification Committee:

Establish a "Radio Technician I" classification, class code 409100, on pay range 35. (Pay range 35 has a minimum salary of \$38,480 and a maximum salary of \$57,740.)

Establish a "Radio Technician II" classification, class code 409101, on pay range 39. (Pay range 39 has a minimum salary of \$42,473 and a maximum salary of \$63,731.)

Commissioner Miller seconded the motion.


