FINDING OF PUBLIC NUISANCE AND ORDER FOR ABATEMENT

NOW on this 16th day of June 2015, the County Commission of Boone County, Missouri met in regular session and entered the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and order for abatement of nuisance:

Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law

The County Commission finds as fact and concludes as a matter of law the following:

- 1. The Boone County Code of Health Regulations (the "Code") are officially noticed and are made a part of the record in this proceeding.
- 2. The City of Columbia/Boone County Health Department administrative record is made a part of the record in this proceeding and incorporated herein by reference. In addition, any live testimony of the official(s) of the department and other interested persons are made a part of the record in this proceeding.
- 3. A public nuisance exists described as follows: growth of weeds in excess of twelve inches high on the premises.
- 4. The location of the public nuisance is as follows: 7004 N. Moberly Drive, a/k/a parcel# 11-606-14-01-040.00 01, Section 14, Township 49, Range 13 as shown in deed book 4413 page 0103, Boone County.
- 5. The specific violation of the Code is: growth of weeds in excess of twelve inches high in violation of section 6.7 of the Code.
- 6. The Health Director's designated Health Official made the above determination of the existence of the public nuisance at the above location. Notice of that determination and the requirement for abatement was given in accordance with section 6.10.1 of the Code on the 11th day of May to the property owner.
- 7. The above described public nuisance was not abated. As required by section 6.10.2 of the Code, the property owner was given notice of the hearing conducted this date before the Boone County Commission for an order to abate the above nuisance at government expense with the cost and expense thereof to be charged against the above described property as a special tax bill and added to the real estate taxes for said property for the current year.
- 8. No credible evidence has been presented at the hearing to demonstrate that no public nuisance exists or that abatement has been performed or is unnecessary; accordingly, in accordance with section 6.10.2 of the Code and section 67.402, RSMo, the County Commission finds and determines from the credible evidence presented that a public nuisance exists at the above location which requires abatement and that the parties

responsible for abating such nuisance have failed to do so as required by the Health Director or Official's original order referred to above.

Order For Abatement Chargeable As a Special Assessment To The Property

Based upon the foregoing, the County Commission hereby orders abatement of the above described public nuisance at public expense and the Health Director is hereby authorized and directed to carry out this order.

It is further ordered and directed that the Health Director submit a bill for the cost and expense of abatement to the County Clerk for attachment to this order and that the County Clerk submit a certified copy of this order and such bill to the County Collector for inclusion as a special assessment on the real property tax bill for the above described property for the current year in accordance with section 67.402, RSMo.

PARKING AREA USE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into by and between the County of Boone, 801 E. Walnut, Room #333, Columbia, Missouri 65201 (County) and the Illinois National Guard (Tenant).

WHEREAS, County owns real property and improvements located at 5212 North Oakland Gravel Road, commonly known as the Boone County Fairgrounds; and

WHEREAS, County has closed the Boone County Fairgrounds and is currently minimally maintaining the property; and

WHEREAS, Tenant wishes to use a portion of the Fairgrounds parking areas to park participant automobiles and up to 10 Humvees for an exercise to be held elsewhere; and

WHEREAS, County cannot warrant the condition of the property as suitable for any particular use, including the use anticipated by Tenant.

WHEREAS, despite the inability of County to maintain the property and ensure the same will be suitable for Tenant's desired use, Tenant desires to use the Demised Premises for such vehicular parking; and

WHEREAS, Tenant has agreed to accept the property in "as is" condition without any guarantees regarding the condition of the premises;

The parties hereto agree as follows:

1. The term of the Agreement shall be from June 14, 2015 until June 18, 2015.

2. There shall be no rental for the entire term.

3. The Demised Premises are depicted in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and shall be used for vehicle parking only. Tenant's use is restricted to the Demised Premises and to ingress and egress via Coliseum Blvd. only.

4. The Tenant shall quietly enjoy full use of the Demised Premises during the entire term of this Agreement.

5. Boone County Missouri hereby represents and warrants it has full authority to enter into this Agreement.

6. Tenant will at all times be responsible for, and bears all risk of loss as to, any damage caused to any part of the premises or to any member of the public by its use of the Demised Premises and shall maintain the area in a neat, clean, and orderly manner, and

shall return the property to County clean and without any excessive wear and tear at the conclusion of Tenant's use.

7. In consideration for the use of Boone County's parking lot as shown on Exhibit "A" during the term of this agreement, Tenant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the County from any and all claims for personal injury, including death, brought against Boone County or its officers, employees, or agents by any person or entity, or any member of the public, related to or involved directly or indirectly in Tenant's exercise.
