Here at the OEM, we want to make sure that your Thanksgiving goes over smoothly and has a safe and happy ending. Follow these Holiday Cooking Safety Tips below to reduce your chances of a kitchen disaster.

- Stay in the kitchen when you are frying, grilling or broiling food. If you leave the kitchen—turn off the stove!
- · Wear short, close-fitting or tightly rolled sleeves when cooking.
- Position grills at least 10 feet away from siding and deck railings, & out from under eaves or branches.
- Keep a fire extinguisher available.

Public Assistance Updates



Boone County currently has two active Public Assistance (PA) applications. The first is for the COVID-19 pandemic and the second is for the flooding events during June 24th—July 1st. The Boone County Office of Emergency Management (OEM) is working with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to submit all costs related to the pandemic. The OEM has submitted 2020 costs and continues to track 2021 costs as they are incurred. In addition, the OEM is actively working with Boone County Road & Bridge to submit all costs associated with flooding of roads and bridges during the flash flooding events earlier this year. Road & Bridge has 100% of road repairs completed to-date and is working diligently to complete bridge repairs by the end of the year.
