

**AMENDED RESOLUTION
BID NUMBER 55-02NOV00**

Fairway Meadows East Pump Station and ABC Labs Sanitary Sewer Extension

NOW on this 1st day of February, 2001, the County Commission of the County of Boone met in session and adopted the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the County of Boone has duly advertised for competitive bid the construction of the project known as **Fairway Meadows East Pump Station and ABC Labs Sanitary Sewer Extension**, and

WHEREAS, Capital Railroad Contracting, Inc., was the apparent lowest and best bid submitted,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the County of Boone hereby awards the contract for the construction of the project known as **Fairway Meadows East Pump Station and ABC Labs Sanitary Sewer Extension** to Capital Railroad Contracting, Inc., of Columbia, Missouri, in the base amount of \$281,710.16, plus the totalizing flowmeter for an additive cost of \$7,500.00, and total contract price not to exceed \$289,210.16 and subject to (1) execution of contract documents by the Presiding Commissioner of Boone County and an authorized representative of Capital Railroad Contracting, Inc., (2) submission and approval of required bonding documents and insurance certificates, and (3) approval by the Missouri Department of Natural Resources of contract award requirements for participation in the Missouri State Revolving Fund.





SUBJECT: SRF Loan Application for South Route K NID and Hackberry NID

The State Revolving Fund administered by the Department of Natural Resources is available to Nighborhood Improvement District (NID) projects. The interest rate is usually between 1.75% to 2.5 %. Costs eligible for SRF financing would include engineering, construction, inspection and equipment.

The attached is a SRF loan application for the South Rt. K and Hackberry Sanitary Sewer NID projects. According to the latest estimates the total project costs including non-eligible costs is \$2,782,486. Of this total \$1,994,746 may be financed by the SRF.

The Boone County Commission has the bonding authority to apply for these funds as a result of the November 1997 passage of the \$5.5 million general obligation bond election to fund NIDs to construct public sanitary sewer systems.

During the past year, the Planning Department processed 18 requests to rezone land. Fourteen of the requests were considered by the County Commission, but only 12 requests were ultimately approved.

The requests that received approval totaled 326.24 acres of land. The largest request that was approved involved rezoning land that was zoned A-2 (Agriculture) to several different zoning classifications. That request totaled 117 acres.
