**PURCHASE AGREEMENT  
FOR  
PORTABLE AND VEHICLE MOUNTED RADIOS**

**THIS AGREEMENT** dated the 23 day of MARCH 2004 is made between Boone County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri through the Boone County Commission, herein "County" and **Chariton Valley TriStar Communications**, herein, "Contractor."

**IN CONSIDERATION** of the parties performance of the respective obligations contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. **Contract Documents** - This agreement shall consist of this purchase agreement for **Portable and Vehicle Mounted Radios**, State of Missouri Contract for Telecommunications Services: Long Distance Services number **C002003001**, Request for Proposal number BO02003, Amendment Numbers One, Two, Three and Four, as well as the Contractor's bid response dated September 9, 1999 and executed by Michael L. Baker on behalf of the Contractor. All such documents shall constitute the contract documents, true copies of the same being attached hereto and maintained in the Boone County Purchasing Department and are incorporated herein by reference. In the event of conflict between any of the foregoing documents, the terms, conditions, provisions and requirements contained in the proposal specifications and proposal sheets for the term and supply contract, contractual requirements, shall prevail and control over the Contractor's bid response.
2. **Basic Services** - The County agrees to purchase from the Contractor and the Contractor agrees to supply the County with four (4) Kenwood 110 Watt remote head radios (TK-790HBK9fHSHI) at a unit price of \$1,221.00 and four (4) Federal Smart Siren and Light controllers at a unit price of \$977.00. Total contract price is \$8,792.00.
3. **Delivery** - Contractor agrees to deliver the items as specified within four (4) weeks from date of order.
4. **Billing and Payment** - All billing shall be invoiced to each the Boone County Sheriff's department. Billings may only include the prices listed in the Contractor's proposal response. The County agrees to supply the Contractor with a list of phone numbers under each department. The County agrees to pay all invoices within thirty days of receipt. No other fees shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in the Contractor's response to the proposal specifications. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount; in the event the billing dispute is resolved in favor of the Contractor, the County agrees to pay interest at a rate of 9% per annum on disputed amounts withheld commencing from the last date that payment was due.


- 5. **Binding Effect** - This agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this agreement remains in full force and effect.
- 6. **Entire Agreement** - This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior negotiations, written or verbal, and any other proposal or proposal specification or contractual agreement. This agreement may only be amended by a signed writing executed with the same formality as this agreement.
- 7. **Termination** - This agreement may be terminated by the County upon ten days advance written notice for any of the following reasons or under any of the following circumstances.
  - a. County may terminate this agreement due to material breach of any term or condition of this agreement, or
  - b. County may terminate this agreement if in the opinion of the Boone County Commission service is chronically deficient such that it is unreasonable to continue services pursuant to this agreement, or
  - c. If appropriations are not made available and budgeted for any calendar year.







After due diligence and relying heavily on the City of Columbia's tree program, we respectfully submit, for your perusal, the following program particulars.

The City of Columbia's Park and Recreation Department has conducted this same program for several years successfully. We therefore believe this program will meet our needs.

BOONE COUNTY BOARD OF PARKS COMMISSION  
MEMORIAL HERITAGE TREE PROGRAM

Sponsored by the Boone County Board of Parks Commission. Please refer to enclosures.

Cost of the program is \$215 per tree. This includes the tree, plaque and continued maintenance of the tree after planting.

After a tree has been planted the donor will receive a certificate and a map of the planting location.

Trees ordered from April 15 through October 15 will be planted in the fall. Trees ordered from October 16 through April 14 will be planted in the spring.

Planting location will be on the county trail system, county parks or the Boone County Fairgrounds. Exact planting location will be at the discretion of the Boone County Board of Parks and Boone County Facilities Maintenance department. Trees planted on the MKT trail will be planted a minimum of 5 feet from the edge of the trail surface to allow for mowing.

Typical planting times are: Spring – middle of March through April. Fall – September through October. Typical tree size will be 2 feet, balled and burlapped. Plaques are black plastic 5 3/8" x 6", mounted on a 6"x6" post, cut on a 45% angle. Post will be 2 feet in length, with 1 foot in the ground.

We will offer twelve or more tree choices that are best suited for this area. Approximate first year costs of Memorial Tree Program:

Wood Post	\$ 4 - \$ 5
Stakes & Ties	\$ 6 - \$ 8
