FINDING OF PUBLIC NUISANCE AND ORDER FOR ABATEMENT

NOW on this 18thd day of August, 2009, the County Commission of Boone County, Missouri met in regular session and entered the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and order for abatement of nuisance:

Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law

The County Commission finds as fact and concludes as a matter of law the following:

- 1. The Boone County Code of Health Regulations (the "Code") are officially noticed and are made a part of the record in this proceeding.
- 2. The City of Columbia/Boone County Health Department administrative record is made a part of the record in this proceeding and incorporated herein by reference. In addition, any live testimony of the official(s) of the department and other interested persons are made a part of the record in this proceeding.
- 3. A public nuisance exists described as follows: weeds in excess of twelve inches high
- 4. The location of the public nuisance is as follows: 6003 Gregory Drive Lot 5 Gregory Heights a/k/a parcel# 12-415-20-01-046.00 01, Section 20, Township 49, Range 12 as shown by deed book 2444 page 0082, Boone County
- 5. The specific violation of the Code is: weeds in excess of twelve inches high in violation of section 6.7 of the Code
- 6. The Health Director's designated Health Official made the above determination of the existence of the public nuisance at the above location. Notice of that determination and the requirement for abatement was given in accordance with section 6.10.1 of the Code on the 19 day of 4ue, 2009, to the property owner, occupant, and any other applicable interested persons.
- 7. The above described public nuisance was not abated. As required by section 6.10.2 of the Code, the property owner, occupant, and any other applicable interested persons were given notice of the hearing conducted this date before the Boone County Commission for an order to abate the above nuisance at government expense with the cost and expense thereof to be charged against the above described property as a special tax bill and added to the real estate taxes for said property for the current year.
- 8. No credible evidence has been presented at the hearing to demonstrate that no public nuisance exists or that abatement has been performed or is unnecessary; accordingly,

in accordance with section 6.10.2 of the Code and section 67.402, RSMo, the County Commission finds and determines from the credible evidence presented that a public nuisance exists at the above location which requires abatement and that the parties responsible for abating such nuisance have failed to do so as required by the Health Director or Official's original order referred to above.

Order For Abatement Chargeable As a Special Assessment To The Property

Based upon the foregoing, the County Commission hereby orders abatement of the above described public nuisance at public expense and the Health Director is hereby authorized and directed to carry out this order.

It is further ordered and directed that the Health Director submit a bill for the cost and expense of abatement to the County Clerk for attachment to this order and that the County Clerk submit a certified copy of this order and such bill to the County Collector for inclusion as a special assessment on the real property tax bill for the above described property for the current year in accordance with section 67.402, RSMo.

For 3 items pertaining to the Lakewood NID:

- 1) That all streets in the development be allowed at the current 24 foot width instead of the standard 32 foot width, and that parking be allowed on one side, which will be consistent, throughout the development.
- 2) a. That Lakewood Drive be allowed a 32 foot wide residential cross section instead of the standard 38 foot wide collector road,
 b. That roller compacted concrete be allowed as an alternate bid in place of Type I rolled stone & base rock and plant mix bituminous base on Lakewood Drive, Aspen Circle, Pinehurst Lane, Vail Court and Villa Drive
 c. Allow 18 inch wide curb section instead of 30" wide curb section on Lakewood Drive, Aspen Circle, Pinehurst Lane, Vail Court and Villa Drive
 d. Allow rollback curb alternative to match existing conditions (which allows parking to mount the curb without tire or wheel damage) on Lakewood Drive, Aspen Circle, Pinehurst Lane, Vail Court and Villa Drive
- 3) Allow pipe under roadway to be HDPE or Aluminized instead of Polymeric Coated and end sections shall be mitered as per the standard metal pipe.

I V .	Variance Request:	
1.	Lakewood NID – Public Works – 3 items	

Mr. Campbell distributed a detailed memo outlining each of the variance requests. Stated they tried to address all variance requests at one time, and prior to beginning construction.

a. Width of roadways & parking on one side of roadway

Existing road width is 24'. As this is a NID and we are trying to upgrade the current road for the County to take over maintenance. Widening the road to the current standard of 32' for Aspen Circle, Pinehurst Lane, & Villa Drive would be cost prohibitive and end up with the road being nearly in the living room of individuals living there. With this variance we would actually need to reduce the width of Vail Court to 24' so all of the roads in the subdivision are the same width.

Road and Bridge Advisory Committee – August 6, 2009 – Minutes

Removing trees and reducing the width of Vail Court will also save some money. Area is an older development that was established prior to rules being in place that require public roads be built to specific standards. Another problem arising because of the age of the sub division is the lack of off street parking, so Public Works is also requesting that parking be allowed on one side of the 24' wide street through out the sub division. The side of the street selected for parking would remain consistent throughout the development. This has been discussed with the Boone County Fire District, and all though they are not excited about the 24 foot road with parking on one side, they understand the need for it. Question was asked about the type & condition of the current road. Mr. Campbell stated is concrete and in horrible shape. Is privately maintained but have not spent any money on maintenance. Mr. Yonke stated subdivision was built before there were requirements that they do proper maintenance. Question was asked about how long before this became city. Mr. Campbell said in its current state never. Mr. Yonke added that it would not be likely to be annexed because the City would have to do so forcibly and they have not been successful with that in the past 20 years.

- b. Typical road cross-sections
 - 1) Allow Lakewood Drive be built to 32' wide Residential Cross section instead of 38' wide Collector Road.
 - 2) Allow for Roller Compacted concrete instead of Type 1 rolled stone & base rock and plant mix bituminous base.
 - 3) Allow 18" wired curb section instead of 30" wide curb section
 - 4) Rollback curb alternative will be used to match existing conditions which allows parking to mount the curb without tire or wheel damage.

c. Storm water pipe specification Allow pipe under roadway to be HDPE or Aluminized instead of Polymeric Coated and end sections shall be mitered as per the standard metal pipe.

Dr. Satalowich moved approval for the variance. Mr. Yonke clarified that the move for approval was for all 3 items on the variance request be done as a package. Mr. Martin seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

V. **Old Business:** Mr. Campbell gave an update on the situation with Mr. Kramer (Trail West retaining wall). The commission asked that the solution be for the County to seed & mulch the disturbed area. Mr. Campbell stated he attempted to contact the term & supply contractor for seeding & mulching today (8/6/09) but had to leave a message.

Dr. Satalowich asked about plans for Rock Quarry Road. Mr. Campbell answered no current plans for any construction or changes.

- VI. **New Business:** Mr. Campbell gave a notice that next month will probably have another request for a retaining wall. This one is on Richland Road and will be similar to the problem discussed last month. Agreed with Mr. Yonke that County does have a 50' right of way on this road.
- VII. Adjourn Mr. Yonke moved to adjourn. Mr. Martin seconded the motion. Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 5:48pm.
