The Bid for Creasy Springs Road & Roemer Road Asphalt Overlay, 2011 Pavement Preservation closed on March 24, 2011. Two bids were received. Purchasing and the Planning and Building department recommend award to APAC Missouri for offering the lowest and best bid for Boone County.

The Bid Amount for this project was \$408,610.81. The R.A.P. (Recycled Asphalt Product) deduction from the bid amount is equal to \$2.00 per ton multiplied by 4,202 estimated tons, for a deduction of \$8,404.00. The Warm Mix Deduction from the bid amount is equal to \$0.50 per ton multiplied by 4,202 estimated tons, for a deduction of \$2,101.00. The R.A.P. and Warm Mix deductions bring the bid amount to \$398,105.81. After including a 5% contingency amount of \$19,905.29, this project has a Purchase Order total of \$418,011.10. Invoices from this contract will be paid from department 2041 - PW - Pavement Preservation, account 71100 - Outside Services. The engineer's estimated amount was \$473,977.00.

The contractor agrees that he will comply with all federal, state, and local laws and regulations and ordinances and that he/she will comply and cause each of his/her subcontractors, and directives pertaining to nondiscrimination against any person on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in connection with this contract, including procurement of materials and lease of equipment; therefore, in accordance with the special provisions on that subject attached hereto, incorporated in and made a part of the Contract.

The Contractor expressly warrants that he/she has employed no third person to solicit or obtain this contract in his behalf, or to cause or procure the same to be obtained upon compensation in any way contingent, in whole or in part, upon such procurement; and that he has not paid, or promised or agreed to pay to any third person, in consideration of such procurement, or in compensation for services in connection therewith, any brokerage, commission or percentage upon the amount receivable by him hereunder; and that he has not, in estimating the contract price demand by him, included any sum by reason of such brokerage, commission, or

percentage; and that all moneys payable to him hereunder are free from obligation of any other person for services rendered, or supposed to have been rendered, in the procurement of this contract.
