Joe,

The culvert needs to be an 18" pipe and I will send out a narrative of what is required. I don't intend to do an actual drawing as we have not topo'd the current conditions.

I believe that we need to find a way to get the majority of the water into the inlet or another method of getting the water from the pavement to the pond. Simply grading the gravel to make it drain to the pond would likely cause an erosion issue (similar to the washout at the above mentioned pipe).

Freally need to keep this moving as Fbelieve the Commissioner wants this to be completed by the 9/11 building dedication.


