The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m.

Family Court Services

1. First reading; Budget Amendment to increase revenue and expenditures for the Disproportionate Minority Contact Grant

Cindy Garrett said the grant has been awarded to fund the curriculum and implementation of the Columbia Public School's Teen Court class. \$800 of the total will be used for a field trip and two substitute teachers.

There were no comments or questions,

Commissioner Atwill stated there is a mandatory 10 day waiting period for Budget Amendments and a second reading will be scheduled appropriately.

2. First reading; Budget Amendment to increase revenue and expenditures for the Multidisciplinary Training for Child Welfare Cases Grant

Cindy Garrett said that this grant has been approved for \$3,000 to bring in the National Drug Endangered Children Association as well as the Missouri ACT Program to assist local law enforcement juvenile officers and children's division in developing protocols when assisting families engaged in drug activity. This is scheduled for June.

Commissioner Atwill stated there is a mandatory 10 day waiting period for Budget Amendments and a second reading will be scheduled appropriately.

3. First reading; Budget Amendment to increase revenue and expenditures for travel to Colorado regarding the operation of Juvenile Assessment Center locations

Cindy Garrett said the funds have been received to send a group to Colorado to look at their three assessment centers with the possibility of developing one here in Columbia. This grant will provide the travel, meals and lodging for those individuals who will be going on the trip.

Commissioner Miller asked what individuals will be going on the trip.

Cindy Garrett said it will be herself, Kathy Lloyd, Kelly Wallis, Joanne Nelson, Chief Burton, Seth Bauman (State DMC Coordinator), Dr. Lou Ann Tanner-Jones (Columbia Public Schools) and Wendy Reinke (University of Missouri, Department of Education)

Commissioner Atwill stated there is a mandatory 10 day waiting period for Budget Amendments and a second reading will be scheduled appropriately.

Information Technology

4. First reading; Budget Revision to replace 2 Storage Area Network Devices

Aron Gish said Information Technologies is seeking approval to purchase two replacement storage area network devices. These SANs are used for our virtual server environment and serve as the storage for many systems like the County's primary shared drives, Cartegraph server, Mobile Email Sync server, Maintenance Connection server and many more business critical applications.

Mr. Gish said he is requesting this budget revision to move forward as soon as possible to allow IT to say on track with our work plan for FY2014. IT had anticipated using vSphere Storage software utility from VMWare to leverage internal storage of the replacement VMWare servers for FY2014 projects. However, VMWare has since discontinued this software offering and replaced it with a much more expensive solution that is not cost effective to our environment. The recommendation is to replace the two existing SANs with current technology and more usable storage. Replacing these units now will allow us to move forward with projects such as Novell Filr server, Webmail Upgrade, Track-it Upgrade and the Netmotion server for the Sheriff's Department. The recommendation to replace these SANs would have been part of the IT FY2015 budget request as a need to increase storage capacity.

We are asking to move this to 2014 so we can continue. We are running very low on space for the S and L drives. We have been in consultation with the Auditor's Office on this request.

There were no comments or questions.

Commissioner Atwill stated this is a first reading and requested the Deputy County Clerk to

schedule this item for a second reading at the next available commission meeting with appropriate order for approval.
