# 8. 1st & 2nd reading; User Agreement with St. Louis County

Stephanie Browning said this is the second part to the adoption of the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program. It is a User Agreement with St. Louis County. The agreement outlines the subscription cost for Boone County joining the program.

The annual cost will be \$236.75 and is based on the number of county users, which at this time, there are 17, as well as administrative costs calculated by the percent of total users across the state. The cost for year one will be pro-rated as to the go-live date, which will be July 1<sup>st</sup>. We will pay for this out of the existing department budget and at the end of the year, when we reconcile, it will be all squared up. There are no additional appropriations needed.

There are no costs to pharmacies or healthcare providers for accessing the program. Also, St. Louis County has recently submitted a grant application to the Bureau of Justice Administration. If they are successful, which we will find out in September, the first two years of cost, for the city and county, will be covered. If there are no grant funds, the first bill is due in November for year one and then on January for each succeeding year.

Commissioner Parry asked if it is \$236.75 per user.

Ms. Browning said it is \$236.75 for the entire year, not dependent on the number of users.

There were no further comments or questions.
