**Resource Management**

- 1. First Reading; Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement: Hinkson Creek Synoptic Sampling Project with The Curators of the University of Missouri**

Nicki Fuemmeler explained this was a continuation of the sampling project at Hinkson Creek. It is a cooperative agreement with the City of Columbia. It is a 2-year project in the amount of \$13,285.

Commissioner Thompson asked for an explanation of synoptic sampling for the record.

Lynne Hooper explained synoptic, meaning a multitude of sites along the creek taken on the same day to get an overall picture of what is going on at the creek.

Commissioner Thompson asked how the sites are chosen.

Hooper said sites are picked based on what is relatively easy to access. They spread them out to cover the entire stream.

Commissioner Parry wanted clarification on what was being studied with this project.

Hooper said things such as water temperature, the nutrients in the water, and suspended sediment are being observed in this study.

Commissioner Thompson asked if a portion of the stream is in an area around livestock.

Hooper explained that an upper portion of the creek as well as a lower region have areas of agriculture surrounding them, but she does not believe there is any livestock.

There were no more comments or questions from the Commission.

Commissioner Atwill stated this is a first reading and requested the Deputy County Clerk to schedule this item for a second reading at the next available commission meeting with appropriate order for approval.
