The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. and roll call was taken.

Boone County Sheriff's Office

1. First and Second Reading: MOICAC Task Force Grant Acceptance

Captain Brian Leer stated they received a notice of award from the Missouri Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force (MOICAC). Captain Leer stated that every year, MOICAC provides funding to the Boone County Sheriff's Office since they maintain a task force unit here in Columbia to serve the area of which they are members. They have notified him of a \$14,000 sub-award they want to provide Boone County under the Protect Act through the MOICAC Task Force, which will cover equipment and/or training. Captain Leer stated there was no application required, they just needed to be members. Captain Leer stated they disbursed the money accordingly to the different task forces around the state. Captain Leer stated the funds from this award roll over each year, so if there are unspent funds, it will roll to the next fiscal year.

Commissioner Aldred moved now on this day, the County Commission of the County of Boone does hereby approve the acceptance of the attached MOICAC Task Force Grant award.

Commissioner Kendrick stated the National Weather Service in St. Louis confirmed an EF-1 tornado touched down on Sunday, April 20 within the City of Columbia. Commissioner Kendrick stated, fortunately, there was adequate warning from both the Weather Service and the Boone County Office of Emergency Management on two separate occasions for the tornado warning. Commissioner Kendrick stated, due to those warnings, no injuries or fatalities were reported with this tornado, but there was substantial damage to some City of Columbia facilities.

Commissioner Thompson stated an EF-2 tornado went through New Bloomfield and the City of Fulton discovered their sirens weren't working.

Commissioner Kendrick stated two or three weeks ago, a Pilot Grove siren did not sound. Commissioner Thompson stated the same issue happened in downtown Fulton – the batteries were dead.
