**WHEREAS,** County is reconstructing a portion of Georgetown Subdivision drainage areas (the "Project") which will require Verizon's underground services to be relocated; and

WHEREAS, Verizon has prepared plans for the necessary relocation of its underground utilities; as per letter of estimate, dated May 6, 2002 (attached as Exhibit A); and

WHEREAS, this agreement sets out the duties and responsibilities of each party regarding such relocation.

- 2. County agrees to reimburse Verizon the actual cost of the relocation based on final as-built plans not to exceed **\$4,800.00** without prior written approval of the County.;
