We have pursued these discussions because we believe that such a change would be mutually beneficial and allow us to provide improved service to our clientele.


Our discussions have included future plans to move the morgue to the University property; however, we anticipate that forensic services will continue to be performed at the current medical examiner properties at 5609 Saint Charles Road for the next 18 to 24 months until adequate facilities can be constructed on campus.


The Boone County contract with Fountain Enterprises is valid through December 31, 2004. As of August 1, 2004, the Department of Pathology & Anatomical Sciences, with the full endorsement of Fountain Enterprises, will assume the contract for the remainder of the term.
