Contract Documents This agreement shall consist of this Purchase Agreement for Long Distance Telephone Service Term and Supply, Request for Bid Number 40-28JUL04 Long Distance Telephone Service, including Introduction and General Conditions of Bidding, Primary Specifications, Response Presentation and Review, the unexecuted Response Form, Standard Terms & Conditions, the Contractor's bid response dated July 27, 2002 and executed by Paul Palecek on behalf of the Contractor, Best and Final Offer, and the Fax Memo dated August 31, 2004. All such documents shall constitute the contract documents, which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Service or product data, specification and literature submitted with bid response may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office bid file for this bid if not attached. 
