PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR GUARDRAIL REPAIR SERVICES – TERM & SUPPLY

THIS AGREEMENT dated the ______ day of ______ CTOBER_ 2004 is made between Boone County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri through the Boone County Commission, herein "County" and James H. Drew Corporation, herein "Contractor."

IN CONSIDERATION of the parties performance of the respective obligations contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Contract Documents This agreement shall consist of this Purchase Agreement for Guardrail Repair Services Term & Supply, County of Boone Request for Bid for Guardrail Repair Services Term & Supply, bid number 61-16SEP04, Introduction and General Conditions of Bidding, Primary Specifications, Response Presentation and Review, any applicable addenda, the unexecuted Response Form, Exhibit A-Prior Experience, Standard Terms and Conditions, as well as the Contractor's bid response dated September 13, 2004 and executed by Gregory A. Peck on behalf of the Contractor. All such documents shall constitute the contract documents which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Service or product data, specification and literature submitted with bid response may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office bid file for this bid if not attached. In the event of conflict between any of the foregoing documents, the Introduction and General Conditions of Bidding, Primary Specifications, Response Presentation and Review, the unexecuted Response Form, Exhibit A-Prior Experience, Standard Terms and Conditions, and applicable Addenda shall prevail and control over the Contractor's bid response.
- 2. Contract Duration This agreement shall commence on October 1, 2004 through September 30, 2005 subject to the provisions for termination specified below. This agreement may be extended beyond the expiration date by order of the County for two (2) additional one-year periods subject to the pricing clauses in the Contractor's bid response and thereafter on a month to month basis for a maximum of six (6) months in the event the County is unable to re-bid and/or award a new contract prior to the expiration date after exercising diligent efforts to do so or not.
- 3. *Basic Services* The County agrees to purchase from the Contractor and the Contractor agrees to supply the County with Guardrail Repair Services. Items will be provided as required in the bid specifications and in conformity with the contract documents for the prices set forth in the Contractor's bid response, as needed and as ordered by County.
- **4.** *Delivery* Contractor agrees to provide the items and service as specified and as agreed to in the bid specifications.
- 5. Billing and Payment All billing shall be invoiced to Boone County Public Works and billings may only include the prices listed in the Contractor's bid response. No additional fees for delivery or extra services not included in the bid response or taxes shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in the Contractor's bid response to the specifications. The County agrees to pay all invoices within thirty days of receipt; Contractor agrees to honor any cash or prompt payment discounts offered in its bid response if county makes payment as provided therein. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount; in the event the billing dispute is resolved in favor of the Contractor, the County agrees to pay interest at a rate of 9% per annum on disputed amounts withheld commencing from the last date that payment was due.
- **6.** Binding Effect This agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this agreement remains in full force and effect.

7. Entire Agreement - This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior negotiations, written or verbal, and any other bid or bid specification or contractual agreement. This agreement may only be amended by a signed writing executed with the same formality as this agreement.

PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR 2004 SNOW PLOW BLADES

THIS AGREEMENT dated the ______ day of ______ 2004 is made between Boone County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri through the Boone County Commission, herein "County" and GM Supply Co., Inc., herein "Contractor."

IN CONSIDERATION of the parties performance of the respective obligations contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Contract Documents This agreement shall consist of this Purchase Agreement for 2004 10' and 11' Snow Plow Blades, bid number 65-23SEP04 including Introduction and General Conditions of Bidding, Primary Specifications, Response Presentation and Review, the unexecuted Response Form, Standard Terms & Conditions, as well as the Contractor's bid response dated September 17, 2004 executed by William P. Tieder, on behalf of the Contractor. All such documents shall constitute the contract documents which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Service or product data, specification and literature submitted with bid response may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office bid file for this bid if not attached. In the event of conflict between any of the foregoing documents, the terms, conditions, provisions and requirements contained in the bid specifications including Introduction and General Conditions of Bidding, Primary Specifications, Response Presentation and Review, the unexecuted Response Form, and Standard Terms & Conditions shall prevail and control over the Contractor's bid response.
- 2. **Purchase** The County agrees to purchase from the Contractor and the Contractor agrees to supply the County with one hundred fifty (150) 10' snow plow blades and ten (10) 11' snow plow blades for a total cost of Twenty Thousand Four Dollars (\$20,004.00).
- 3. **Delivery** Contractor agrees to install and deliver the equipment per the bid specifications and within 5 to 6 weeks after receipt of order.
- 4. Billing and Payment All billing shall be invoiced to Boone County Public Works
 Department and billings may only include the prices listed in the Contractor's bid response. No
 additional fees for delivery or extra services or taxes shall be included as additional charges in
 excess of the charges in the Contractor's bid response to the specifications. The County agrees to
 pay all invoices within thirty days of receipt; Contractor agrees to honor any cash or prompt
 payment discounts offered in its bid response if county makes payment as provided therein. In
 the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed
 amount; in the event the billing dispute is resolved in favor of the Contractor, the County agrees
 to pay interest at a rate of 9% per annum on disputed amounts withheld commencing from the
 last date that payment was due.
- 5. **Binding Effect** This agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this agreement remains in full force and effect.


