- 1. Purpose: This Notice provides guidance to Public Housing Agencies regarding the submission of the Form HUD-50071, Certification for Contracts, Grants, Loan and Cooperative Agreements, as required by the Byrd Amendment.
- 2. Background: Prior to the issuance of the new revised Consolidated Annual Contributions Contracts (CACCs), which were transmitted under Notice PIH 98-21, housing agencies (HAs) were required to submit Form $\underline{\text{HUD}-50071}$ with their CACC whenever the HA executed an amendment to the CACC to add budget authority for increments exceeding \$100,000. However, the new revised CACC issued on April 7, 1998, eliminates the need for HUD to prepare a CACC on Form $\underline{\text{HUD}-52520}$ for execution by the HA each time new or renewal funding increments are added after the revised CACC has been executed by the HA.
- 3. Revised Submission Requirements: Henceforth, if an HA receives funds exceeding \$100,000 in budget authority, in any HA fiscal year the HA is required to submit form HUD-50071, Certification for Contracts, Grants, Loan and Cooperative Agreements, certifying that the HA has not and will not make any prohibited payment from federally appropriated funds. In addition, the HA is required to submit Standard Form(SF)-LLL, Disclosure of Lobbying Activities, disclosing any payment made, or agreement to make a payment, with other than federally appropriated funds for influencing or attempting to influence executive or legislative branch personnel in connection with new or renewal funding.

The forms must be submitted with each annual budget submission, which ensures that the requirement is met. HAs will not be permitted to draw on new renewal or incremental funding increments for the Section 8 programs until the Certifications are received by HUD.

MISSOURI HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR HIGHWAY/RAIL CROSSING SIGNAL IMPROVEMENTS

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into by the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission (hereinafter, "Commission"), the Norfolk Southern Railway Company (hereinafter, "Railroad"), and Boone County (hereinafter, "Agency"), pursuant to the terms of a Master Signal Agreement between the Railroad and Commission executed by the Railroad on December 12, 1980, and by the Commission on December 19, 1980, (hereinafter, "Master Agreement").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the installation of flashing light signals and gates with redundant constant warning time circuitry, the installation of sidelights, the installation of a new signal bungalow, the extension of the culvert pipe in the northeast quadrant, and the relocation of the power pole in the northeast quadrant to the north of the culvert pipe appears to be warranted at an existing grade crossing near Centralia, Missouri, where Dinwiddie School Road intersects Railroad's tracks at a point known as DOT # 483 669F; and

WHEREAS, the parties agree that this installation shall be in substantial compliance with the *Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices* (MUTCD), and will enhance safety to both highway and railroad traffic at said grade crossing.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of these premises and of the mutual covenants herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

- (1) <u>PURPOSE</u>: The purpose of this Agreement is to provide for funding, installation, and maintenance of additional warning devices and/or the installation of a high type surface at this roadway-railroad crossing.
- (2) <u>SCOPE OF WORK</u>: The work consists of the installation of flashing light signals and gates with redundant constant warning time circuitry, the installation of sidelights, the installation of a new signal bungalow, the extension of the culvert pipe in the northeast quadrant, and the relocation of the power pole in the northeast quadrant to the north of the culvert pipe by the Railroad.

- (3) <u>FUNDING</u>: The Commission will reimburse the Railroad for seventy-five percent (75%) of the total project cost. The Railroad will assume responsibility for the remaining twenty-five percent (25%) of the total project cost.
- (4) <u>COST OF PROJECT</u>: The cost of the project shall be the total monies expended by the Railroad to complete the installation, all in accordance with the plan and cost estimate developed by the Railroad for this specific project and attached to this Agreement.
- (5) <u>PRELIMINARY WORK</u>: The Railroad will prepare and submit to the Commission a plan and cost estimate for the work as described during the diagnostic review and in accordance with the provisions of the Master Agreement.
- (6) <u>CHANGE ORDERS</u>: If any change is made in the original plan and extent of the work, reimbursement to the Railroad shall be limited to costs covered by a change order having approval of the Commission PRIOR to the performance of the work.
- (7) <u>INSTALLATION</u>: The Railroad, upon receipt of notification from the Commission, shall furnish all labor and material and complete the installation in accordance with the Master Agreements, and in accordance with the plan and estimate attached hereto, and the rules and regulations contained in the Federal-Aid Program Guide.
- (8) SUBCONTRACTOR REQUIREMENT OF COMPETITIVE BIDS: If the Railroad determines to contract any of the work of adjusting its facilities, the Railroad shall obtain at least three (3) competitive bids for the work. If the Railroad solicits bids for the work, the Railroad shall furnish the Commission a tabulation of bids received, a copy of the invitation to bid, and any other information to support the Railroad recommendation for award prior to any contract work being performed. The Railroad shall obtain the Commission's written approval prior to awarding the contract. The Commission's approval or disapproval shall be communicated in writing to the Railroad no later than twenty-one (21) days after the Railroad provides the above information to the Commission. If the Commission fails to notify the Railroad in writing of its decision within the twenty-one (21) day period, the Commission shall be deemed to have approved the Railroad selection.
- (9) MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION: The Railroad shall operate and maintain the warning devices at the Railroad's expense as long as it operates trains through the crossing; or until the Commission orders that signals are no longer necessary at the crossing; or until the crossing is abandoned, closed, or for any reason the operation and maintenance of the signals becomes unnecessary.

- (10) <u>RELOCATION OF SIGNALS</u>: In the event the warning devices become unnecessary for any of the above reasons, the Railroad shall remove and install the devices at another crossing mutually acceptable to the Commission and the Railroad, and subject to the approval of the Commission.
- (11) <u>PAYMENT PROVISIONS</u>: Upon receipt of the Railroad's final statement of costs and after a review of the statement in relation to the work performed, the Commission will reimburse the Railroad for one hundred percent (100%) of the Commission's obligation which is seventy-five percent (75%) of the total project cost. If audit reveals that the Railroad has been overpaid, the Railroad will immediately refund to the Commission such overpayment. If audit reveals that the Railroad has been underpaid, the Commission will reimburse the Railroad for such underpayment.
- (12) <u>AGENCY OBLIGATION</u>: The Agency hereby agrees to cooperate in the handling of traffic during construction. The Agency is obligated to install and maintain at their expense advance warning signs and pavement markings in accordance with the MUTCD and as instructed by the diagnostic review.
- (13) <u>AMENDMENTS</u>: Any change in this Agreement, whether by modification or supplementation, must be accomplished by a formal contract amendment signed and approved by the duly authorized representative of the parties.
- (14) <u>COMMISSION REPRESENTATIVE</u>: The Commission's director is designated as the Commission's representative for the purpose of administering the provisions of this Agreement.
- (15) <u>ASSIGNMENT</u>: The Railroad shall not assign, transfer, or delegate any interest in this Agreement without the prior written consent of the Commission.
- (16) <u>LAW OF MISSOURI TO GOVERN</u>: This Agreement shall be construed according to the laws of the State of Missouri. The Railroad and the Agency shall comply with all local, state and federal laws and regulations relating to the performance of this Agreement.
- (17) <u>VENUE</u>: It is agreed by the parties that any action at law, suit in equity, or other judicial proceeding to enforce or construe this Agreement, or regarding its alleged breach, shall be instituted only in the Circuit Court of Cole County, Missouri.
- (18) <u>CANCELLATION</u>: The Commission may cancel this Agreement at any time for a material breach of contractual obligations by providing the Railroad with written notice of cancellation. Should the Commission exercise its right to cancel the Agreement for such reasons, cancellation will become effective upon the date specified in the notice of cancellation sent to the Railroad.

- (19) <u>AUDIT OF RECORDS</u>: The Railroad shall maintain all records relating to this Agreement, including but not limited to invoices, payrolls, etc. These records must be available at all reasonable times at no charge to the Commission and/or its designees or representatives during the period of this Agreement and any extension thereof, and for three (3) years from the date of final payment made under this Agreement.
- (20) RAILROAD NOTIFICATION: At least five (5) days prior to the commencement of work, the Railroad shall notify the Commission of the date it plans to commence said work. If the Commission does not receive said notification from the Railroad, the Commission will withhold an amount of five percent (5%) of the final payment to the Railroad. Such five percent (5%) payment will not be provided to the Railroad until after a final audit has been performed by the Commission.
- (21) <u>AUTHORITY TO EXECUTE</u>: The signers of this Agreement warrant that they are acting officially and properly on behalf of their respective institutions and have been duly authorized, directed and empowered to execute this Agreement.

(22) ORIGINAL AGREEMENT: Except as otherwise modified, amended, or supplemented by this Supplemental Agreement, the Master Agreement and all previous Supplemental Agreements between the parties shall remain in full force and effect.






