Re: Speed Limit Recommendations: Mexico Gravel Road

• Speed Limit Recommendations: Mexico Gravel Road (Route PP to Route Z) = 45 mph

The Department was requested by the Commission to evaluate the speed limit on Mexico Gravel Road between Route PP with Route Z. Mexico Gravel Road is an east/west road that connects Route PP with Route Z and then extends east to the Glendale Drive. The current posted speed limit for this road is 35 miles per hour, except between 0.34 miles west of Route Z to Route Z where the speed limit is posted at 25 miles per hour. A speed study using VMIs was completed on May 25 and 26, 2004 as part of the yearly traffic count program. From this study the 85th percentile speeds were determined at three locations. The 85th percentile speed at each location was determined as follows:

- Eastbound lane east of Route PP: 40 miles per hour
- Westbound lane east of Route PP: 44 miles per hour
- Eastbound lane east of Billy Jean Drive: 45 miles per hour
- Westbound lane east of Billy Jean Drive: 44 miles per hour
- Eastbound lane west of Route Z: 45 miles per hour
- Westbound lane west of Route Z: 45 miles per hour

The 85th percentile speed is between 40 and 45 miles per hour at each location studied. The Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices recommends posting that speed limit within 5 miles per hour of the 85th percentile speed of free-flowing traffic. Two reasons that the 85th percentile speed is recommended are (1) the assumption that driving behavior is an extension of social attitude in which the majority of drivers respond in a safe and reasonable manner and (2) research has shown that the 85th percentile speed is the speed where accident involvement is the lowest¹. Therefore, it is recommended to post the speed limit at 45 miles per hour on Mexico Gravel Road between Route PP and Route Z.

It should be noted that THHinc. completed a study of the road in 1998. The study recommended the existing posted speed limits due to objects located in the clear zone along each side of the road. The study did not take into consideration the 85th percentile speed. This practice is conservative in setting speed limits. Finally, the existing pavement markings are for 35 miles per hour and the existing passing zone will have to be remarked as no passing.
