District agrees to document all receipts and expenditures of funds provided pursuant to this agreement and to make all such documentation reasonably available to the County's auditor upon reasonable notice for determination of whether or not the expenditures of funds received are within the scope and purpose of this agreement.
- 4. This agreement may automatically annually renew for one year periods provided District has submitted to County a budget request for each succeeding year and County approves of such budget request and District has otherwise complied with the terms and conditions of this agreement; provided, however, that County shall not be obligated to renew this agreement or provide appropriations for funding any renewal of this agreement for any succeeding year.
- 5. The signatories hereof by execution of this agreement represent that they have obtained all necessary approvals by their respective governing bodies and taken all necessary actions to enter into and bind the parties hereto.
