

The amount awarded for the State Services to Victims Grant for the period of July 2005 through June 2006 is not sufficient to cover all of the necessary expenses associated with the Victim Advocate position. The award did not include Disability Insurance or 401(A) Match expenses and the Health Insurance amount requested was lower than the actual expense due to outdated rate information being used in the grant application.

The Disability Insurance and 401(A) Match expenses were not requested as these line items have not been included in the court's budget documents previously. We became aware of the need to include these items when we received a spreadsheet from the Auditor outlining position expenses. The Auditor is aware of the oversight and we have communicated with department staff to ensure these are included in future grant requests.
