#### SAMPLE EXECUTIVE ORDER

DESIGNATION OF THE NATIONAL INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (NIMS) AS THE BASIS FOR ALL INCIDENT MANAGEMENT IN THE STATE/COMMONWEALTH

WHEREAS, the President in Homeland Security Directive (HSPD) -5, directed the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security to develop and administer a Nationa Incident Management System (NIMS), which would provide a consistent nationwide approach for Federal, State, local, and tribal governments to work together more effectively and efficiently to prevent, prepare for, respond to and recover from dom incidents, regardless of cause, size or complexity;

WHEREAS, the collective input and quidance from all Federal, State, local, and triba homeland security partners has been, and will continue to be, vital to the developme effective implementation and utilization of a comprehensive NIMS;

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable that all Federal, State, local and tribal emergency agencies and personnel coordinate their efforts to effectively and efficie provide the highest levels of incident management;

WHEREAS, to facilitate the most efficient and effective incident management it is cr that Federal, State, local, and tribal organizations utilize standardized terminolog standardized organizational structures, interoperable communications, consolidated action plans, unified command structures, uniform personnel qualification standards, uniform standards for planning, training, and exercising, comprehensive resource management, and designated incident facilities during emergencies or disasters;

WHEREAS, the NIMS standardized procedures for managing personnel, communications, facilities and resources will improve the State's ability to utilize funding to enhance local and state agency readiness, maintain first responder safety and streamline incident management processes.

WHEREAS, the Incident Command System components of NIMS are already an integral part of various incident management activities throughout the State, includ current emergency management training programs; and

WHEREAS, the National Commission on Terrorist Attacks (9-11 Commission) recommended adoption of a standardized Incident Command System;
