AN ORDER AUTHORIZING AN EXTENSION OF THE DUE DATE OF THE COUNTY'S TEMPORARY MUNICIPAL NOTES, SERIES 2009 (LAKEWOOD ESTATES, LAKEWOOD VILLAS AND VALLEY CREEK NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT PROJECT).

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Neighborhood Improvement District Act, Section 67.453 to 67.475, inclusive, of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, as amended (the "Act"), and all other provisions of the laws of the State of Missouri applicable thereto, by proceedings duly had, the County Commission of Boone County, Missouri, duly authorized and has undertaken the Lakewood Estates, Lakewood Villas and Valley Creek Neighborhood Improvement District Project number 9644 (the "Project"), as more fully described in a Resolution approved by the County Commission on May 5, 2009, at an estimated cost of \$741,029.24; and

WHEREAS, all of the cost of the Project is to be paid from assessments against the property within the Lakewood Estates, Lakewood Villas and Valley Creek Neighborhood Improvement District (the "District") pursuant to the Act; and

WHEREAS, in order for the County to provide cash funds to meet its obligations incurred in acquiring and constructing the Project prior to the completion of said improvements and prior to the collection of assessments against the owners of property liable therefor or the issuance of the County's general obligation bonds in the amount of unpaid assessments, the County issued its Temporary Municipal Notes, Series 2009 (Lakewood Estates, Lakewood Villas and Valley Creek Neighborhood Improvement District Project), in the principal amount of \$550,000 (the "NID Notes"), pursuant to the Act and an Order approved by the County Commission on December 22, 2009 (the "Note Order"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Note Order, the outstanding principal of and interest on the NID Notes are due and payable on October 1, 2010; and

WHEREAS, due to unforeseen delays in the completion of the Project, it is necessary to extend the due date of the NID Notes in order to allow additional time for completion of the Project and then, to allow property owners within the boundaries of the District a reasonable amount of time to prepay the final amount of the assessment against their properties, if they so choose, all of which must occur prior to the County's issuance of the long-term general obligation bonds to finance the amount of unpaid assessments; and

WHEREAS, the owners of the NID Notes have agreed to extend the due date for payment of the principal of and interest on the NID Notes to November 1, 2010.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF BOONE COUNTY, MISSOURI:

Section 1. Extension of Due Date. Subject to the County's receipt of written consent of all the owners of the NID Notes, the Note Order is hereby amended to substitute "November 1, 2010" for "October 1, 2010", in each instance where such date appears, with the understanding that the due date for the principal of and interest on the NID Notes shall be extended to November 1, 2010, and that the NID Notes shall continue to bear interest at the rate stated therein until the payment thereof. The Presiding Commissioner and County Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute any and all documents and take such actions as they may deem necessary or advisable in order to carry out and perform the purposes of this Order.

Section 2. Ratification of Note Order. The Note Order is ratified, approved and confirmed in all respects, except as amended by this Order.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Order shall take effect and be in full force from and after its approval by the County Commission.

PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT Tomlin Hill Road Asphalt Overlay Project

THIS AGREEMENT dated this 31 day of 4, 2010, is made and entered into by and between Boone County Missouri, a first class non-charter county and political subdivision of the State of Missouri by and through its County Commission, herein "County," and the Village of Pierpont, a municipal corporation and political subdivision of the State of Missouri herein "Village".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, County has published a Notice to Bidders, Bid Number 33-17JUN10, Project Number 10-650, for certain improvements to Tomlin Hill Road, and

WHEREAS, a portion of the improvements depicted in said Notice to Bidders included improvements within the corporate limits of Village, advertised as a Bid Alternate, and

WHEREAS, Village does not have professional staff to supervise and administer a project of this nature and scope, and

WHEREAS, County is willing to provide supervision and administration of the Bid Alternate within the corporate limits of Village under certain terms and conditions as set out herein, and

WHEREAS, Village has secured the funds necessary to pay its portion of the project (current bid estimate of \$27,158.40, subject to adjustment based upon unit pricing consistent with the administrative practices of the Boone County Public Works Department in administering asphalt overlay projects); and

WHEREAS, both parties are empowered to enter into cooperative agreements for the purposes herein stated pursuant to Section 70.220 RSMo and Section 229.040 RSMo.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual undertakings and agreements herein contained the parties agree as follows:

- Village agrees to County's staff administering this overlay project consistent with the County's normal procedures and protocols, including the following, specific provisions:
 - a. Village will promptly pay, within fifteen (15) days of the request by County staff, its portion of the expenses associated with the project, directly to APAC-Missouri Inc., and provide proof of said payment to County contemporaneously with the issuance of said payment to APAC-Missouri, Inc.
 - b. County staff will request that the Performance Bond and Labor and Material Payment Bond be issued for the full price of the Bid (County portion) and the Bid Alternate (Village portion), on County's standard forms, with County being authorized by Village to take those actions deemed appropriate to ensure the protections afforded by said bonds are given effect to the entire project.
 - c. County will administer the entire project consistent with its normal practices and procedures, including procedures relating to quantity adjustments, inspections, prevailing wage issues and the like, and County will notify Village of any adjustments to the final contract price appropriate for Village's portion of the project (the Bid Alternate work).
- 2. All work shall be performed with County and Village right of way and easements.

- 3. All work shall be subject to final inspection and acceptance by County.
- 4. Both parties shall comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, rules and regulations pertaining to public works contracts.
- 5. The signatories to this agreement by signing this agreement represent that they have obtained authority by order or ordinance to enter into this agreement on behalf of the respective parties hereto and bind such parties to all terms and conditions contained herein.
- 6. This agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their successors in interest.
