Use of Alternate Arterial Street Cross Section for Alder Falls in the Somerset Village Preliminary Plat

Please accept this report in response to the request for variance by A Civil Group. They are requesting to use an arterial cross section that is a hybrid of Boone County and City of Columbia standard details for arterial streets. The proposed cross section combines the 100' right-of-way width from the County detail with the 48' pavement width from the City detail (County's standard width is 52'). Their opinion is that the proposed pavement width will be consistent with future north and south extensions of the road because they feel this area will soon be within the City Limits of Columbia.

The Public Works Department supports this request for variance. We also recommend approval of a variance to Boone County Standard Detail 110.04 (dated 1/29/09) to allow the back of sidewalks on the collector street to be placed 1' inside of the right-of-way instead of the 1'-6" indicated on the detail. This will provide consistency for the sidewalk placement along the arterial and collector streets on this plat.

Dear Mr. Campbell:

On behalf of St. Charles Road Development, LLC, we are requesting the authorization to construct an alternate cross section for use on the proposed Arterial Street, named Alder Falls, as shown on the Somerset Village Preliminary Plat, as well as by exhibit A.

The Arterial cross section we are proposing would be a hybrid of "Minor Arterial Option C" (exhibit C)of the City of Columbia Standards and the Arterial Road with Curb and Gutter as shown by Boone County standards detail 110.06 (exhibit D). Attached is exhibit B showing the proposed cross section. The proposed cross section would have a hundred feet (100') right of way width with a forty eight feet (48') curb and gutter and a five foot and an eight foot sidewalk and pedway, one foot inside the right of way line on each side. All construction procedures and specifications such as concrete strength, thickness, etc will remain in compliance with current Boone County Standards.


By constructing this proposed cross section we believe that the county and city would achieve a more consistent and uniform road as future development and road construction occur. It is our opinion that any future construction of this arterial road to the south or north will most likely be within the City Limits of Columbia. By making this portion of the road match future cross sections we eliminate the constriction and expansion of curb and gutter widths and make a uniform road width. It may also be noted that we are choosing a relatively less intensive pavement section from the city as our template.










Minor Arterial - Option'A'




Minor Arterial - Option 'B'
