Now on this day the County Commission of the County of Boone does hereby take up the matter of the disposition of the 2009 tax sale surplus relating to parcel 16-315-00-14-024.00

Pursuant to the provisions of RSMo §140.230, as revised, the Commission has the authority to approve claims for any tax sale surplus that is being held by the County Treasurer associated with the County Collector's annual tax sale. The owner or owners of the subject real property have a period of three (3) years to make a claim for said surplus. In this instance, the owner of record at the time the subject property went to tax sale was C&M Bonding, Inc., a Missouri corporation that was administratively dissolved as of November 8, 2007. The sole shareholders, officers, and directors of that dissolved corporation have filed an affidavit indicating their status as the only interested parties in said corporation, and they have filed a verified surplus claim with the Boone County Treasurer claiming the tax surplus proceeds through Nadine Oliver, Financial Support Services, PO Box 92, Fairfield, Iowa 52556. The other supporting documentation filed by Nadine Oliver in support of this claim are made a part of this record. The application to the County Treasurer for the surplus funds is timely.

The County Treasurer, based upon the documents presented to her office and made a part of the record before the Commission, is satisfied that C&M Bonding, Inc., is the owner of the subject property and as such is entitled to the total surplus of \$1,593.52, and recommends the Commission approve the same.

NOW, THEREFORE, upon the recommendation of the County Treasurer and the evidence made a part of this record, the County Commission hereby approves the disposition of surplus to C&M Bonding, Inc., in the amount of \$1,593.52 via check payable to C&M Bonding, Inc., and mailed to Nadine Oliver, Financial Support Services, PO Box 92, Fairfield, Iowa 52556.



Contract with Boone County

Please accept this letter of intent relating to Boone County's intended purchase of certain landscaping services from Rost, Inc., for the Courthouse plaza renovation project. The County intends to contract with Rost, Inc., to prepare a conceptual design and ultimately to supply, install, build, and provide the coordination necessary for the accomplishment of this project.

Boone County desires to enter into a full and complete agreement with Rost, Inc., in a form acceptable to County's legal counsel, on or before July 13, 2012. The County plans for that contract to include a project completion date of November 9, 2012. In the event that a contract is not signed on or before such date for any reason or no reason, County shall have the right to terminate the negotiations without liability. The full and complete agreement shall include a completed design with itemized schematics, as well as the fees and identification of reimbursable expenses and/or other costs associated with the proposed products and services.

This is a letter of intent only. It is not intended to be, and shall not constitute in any way a binding or legal agreement, or impose any legal obligation or duty on either County or Rost, Inc.
