





2. That the said decedent died on or about November 3, 2012; that more than one year has elapsed since death; that no administration has been commenced on the estate of said decedent in this state, and that no will of decedent has been offered for probate in this state.
3. That the said decedent was unmarried at the time of his death and that his parents died before him.
4. That at the time of his death, the said decedent was the publicly recorded owner of a property in Boone County, Missouri known and described in Tax Sale Certificate of Purchase # 80 as

“Sec 07 T48 R12, 1403 WILKES BLVD, L3 CHF Werz' SD of the N part of Lts 1, 2 & 3 in Turner's Addn to City of Columbia as shown in Plat Book/Page 2/12” (the “property”).

5. That in August of 2019, the property was sold by the Boone County Collector for delinquent real property taxes.

6. That tax sale of the property created a surplus of \$33,247.26 (the “surplus”).

7. That pursuant to Section 140.230.1, the surplus was paid into the treasury.

8. That in September of 2020, Petitioner timely submitted a claim for the surplus to the Boone County, Missouri Commission (the “BC government”).

9. That the BC government’s release of the surplus to Petitioner is pending the outcome of this case.

10. That no other person or party has filed a claim for the surplus with the BC government pursuant to Section 140.230, RSMo. or this Court.


11. That petitioner is entitled to the relief prayed for in said petition.
