



**PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR
PROFESSIONAL GRADE TOOLS & DIAGNOSTIC EQUIPMENT**

THIS AGREEMENT dated the 13th day of April 2021 is made between Boone County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri through the Boone County Commission, herein "County" and **Snap-On Industrial, a Division of IDSC Holdings, LLC**, herein "Vendor."

IN CONSIDERATION of the parties performance of the respective obligations contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. **Contract Documents** - This agreement shall consist of this Purchase Agreement for a **9600GSO Tool Box and Tool Set**, Snap-On quote numbers IMP-000666982 and TFPQ-11087-04, the State of Missouri Contract **CC190146001** in participation with the National Association of State Purchasing Officials (NASPO) contract SW0818 with any addendums and Boone County Standard Terms and Conditions. All such documents shall constitute the contract documents which are incorporated herein by reference. Service or product data, specification and literature submitted with bid response may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office bid file for this bid if not attached. In the event of conflict between any of the foregoing documents, the NASPO Contract Terms & Conditions shall prevail and control over the vendor's bid response.

2. **Purchase** - The County agrees to purchase from the Vendor and the Vendor agrees to supply the County with one (1) 9600GSO Tool Box and Tool Set as follows:

3. **Delivery** - Vendor agrees to deliver equipment as set forth in the bid documents. Delivery shall be to Boone County Road & Bridge, Attn: Greg Edington, 5551 Tom Bass Rd., Columbia, MO 65201.

4. **Billing and Payment** - All billing shall be invoiced to the Boone County Road & Bridge Department and billings may only include the prices listed in the vendor's quote. No additional fees for paperwork processing, labor, or taxes shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in the Vendor's bid response to the specifications. The County agrees to pay all invoices within thirty days of receipt of an accurate statement. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount; in the event the billing dispute is resolved in favor of the Vendor, the County agrees to pay interest at a rate of 9% per annum on disputed amounts withheld commencing from the last date that payment was due.

5. **Binding Effect** - This agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this agreement remains in full force and effect.

6. **Termination** - This agreement may be terminated by the County upon thirty days advance written notice for any of the following reasons or under any of the following circumstances:

- a. County may terminate this agreement due to material breach of any term or condition of this agreement, or
- b. County may terminate this agreement if in the opinion of the Boone County Commission if delivery of products are delayed or products delivered are not in conformity with bidding specifications or variances authorized by County, or
- c. If appropriations are not made available and budgeted for any calendar year.



All:
I discussed funding solutions with the Commission earlier today for a dual-view x-ray body scanner for the Detention Facility. We agreed that my office (**Jason**) will prepare a General Fund budget amendment (1255- GF Detention Operations) in the amount of \$200,000 and schedule it for a first reading on the next available commission meeting. This will get the lengthy budget amendment processing moving forward as soon as possible: first reading would be Tuesday, March 30th with budget hearing and final approval on Tuesday, April 13th. The final amount of the budget amendment can be adjusted, if needed, prior to approval by the Commission. **Meanwhile, the Commission requests the following information prior to approval of the Budget Amendment on April 13th:**

1. **Procurement: will this be a “sole source” or a “competitive” procurement?** Melinda, please confirm the appropriate procurement method. If competitive procurement is required, is this equipment available on an existing cooperative contract? If so, what is the pricing? If it will be a sole-source procurement, please initiate that process.
2. **Future costs--replacement cycle and on-going annual operating costs:** we need to confirm the replacement cycle and annual operating costs and then identify a funding source(s) for these costs. The Inmate Security Fund monies came up in today’s discussion with the Commission as a potential source for part/all of these future costs. **Jason: please schedule a discussion for you, Dwayne, and me.**
3. **Are there any IT-related considerations?** I noted references to “hardware”, “software”, and “archiving images and data on a remote server” in the attached documents. We need to identify any IT-related impacts on the front-end, so I added Aron to this email thread. **Aron: what impact, if any, to IT-managed resources would be expected from this acquisition? If any, please describe and include an estimated budgetary impact.** (See attached documents. This is all the information I have; please follow-up with the Sheriff’s Office if additional information is needed.)

If I’ve overlooked anything relevant to this decision, please chime-in. We need to expedite a fully-informed decision for the County Commission by April 13th so we appreciate everyone’s efforts in keeping with this deadline.

Dwayne- Thank you for reaching out to me. You requested guidance regarding how to proceed going forward, and my intent herein is to provide such guidance.

I have looped-in Dan because my office will need to interact with all three commissioners going forward. I have also looped-in Purchasing (Melinda) because Purchasing will be responsible for the procurement process. I have looped-in Jason because he will be responsible for the budgetary solution from the Auditor's Office. And finally, I looped-in CJ in case there are legal issues of which we need to be aware. I attached the PDFs you included on your original email for everyone's reference.

My recommendation for moving this forward:

1. Schedule one (or more) meetings with the County Commission and the County Auditor in order to:
 - a. (1) discuss the need;
 - b. (2) identify one or more appropriate funding source(s); and
 - c. (3) place this on a path forward for budgetary approval. This process would culminate with a Commission-approved budget adjustment. My office will assist throughout this process.
2. Once the budget is approved, engage Purchasing to direct the procurement process and/or confirm a sole source procurement situation.
3. Implement the procurement decision.

Regarding the 2020 CARES Act monies awarded to the County: the County Commission completed their award of CARES Act monies some time ago and we are in the final stages of close-out. No monies will be returned to the state.

To move your need forward, I recommend that you schedule a discussion involving all three commissioners, the Purchasing Office, and the Auditor's Office (Jason and me). I'm confident that we will find a suitable solution as we work together.

CJ—if there are any legal issues of which we need to be aware of, please reach out to us.

I wanted to send the quote and sole source documentation to you for our proposed body scanner. I talked with Chad this afternoon and he walked me through the CARES funding process that he was involved in. I have also talked to Janet and Justin about this, so I included them on the email. We have done extensive, albeit quick, research on the different body scanning products available. Major German and Captain Reynolds have conducted two site visits within the last week and we have talked to the different manufacturers on a number of occasions. The body scanner attached is currently being used by Cole and Audrain Counties, and will be purchased by Callaway County as well for their new jail (upon completion). In our research we have found that jails across the country are obtaining these body scanners through CARES funding. The body scanners allow for increased social distancing (less contact searches) and eliminates potential contact with bodily fluids.

I am looking for guidance on how to proceed. It is my understanding any CARES money not used by the end of March has to be returned. Obviously, I would like to act as soon as possible due to the deadline, as well as the safety and security of our jail facility.

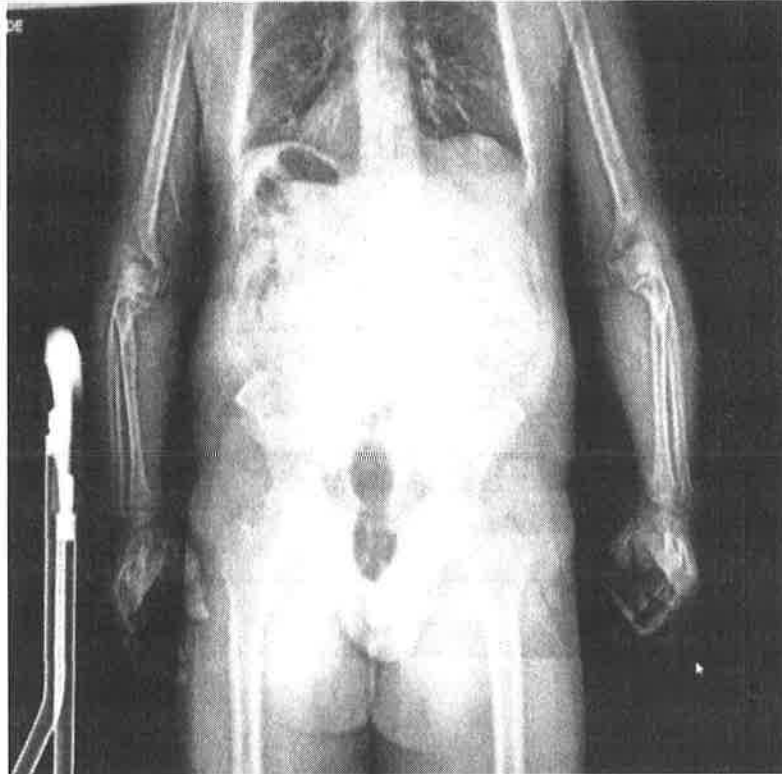

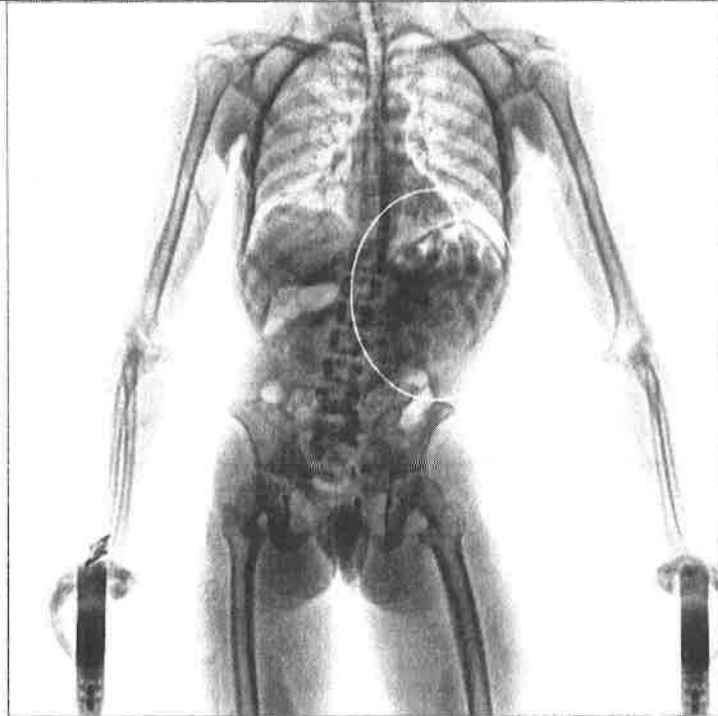

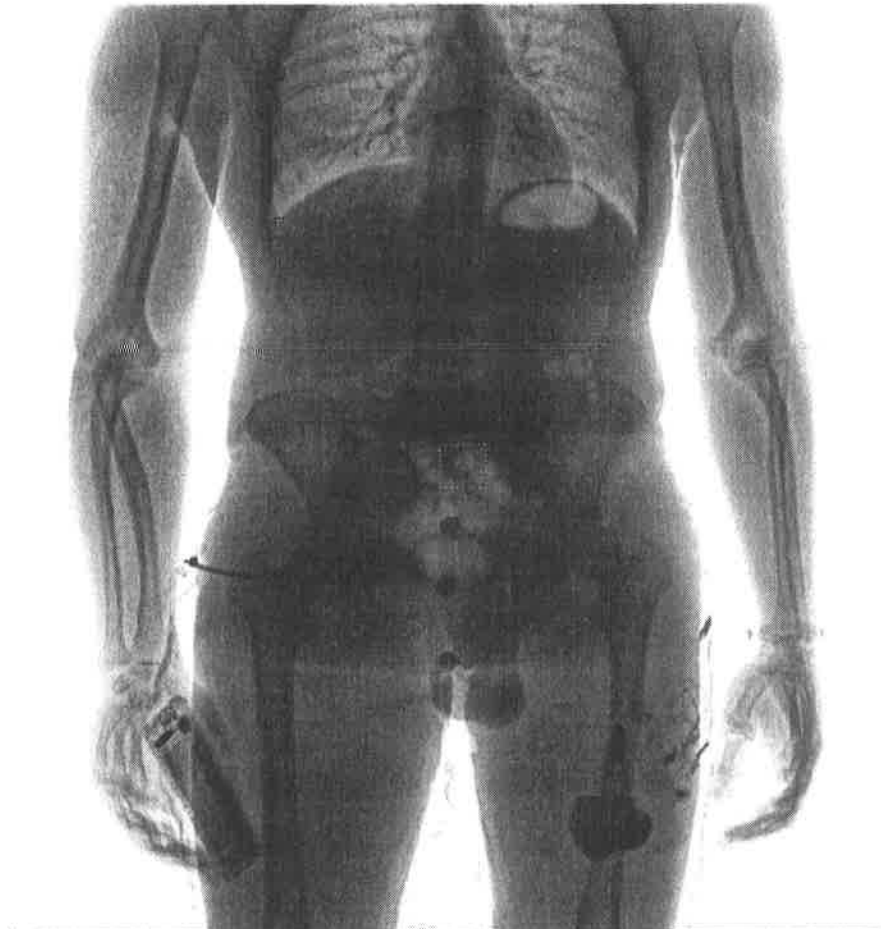

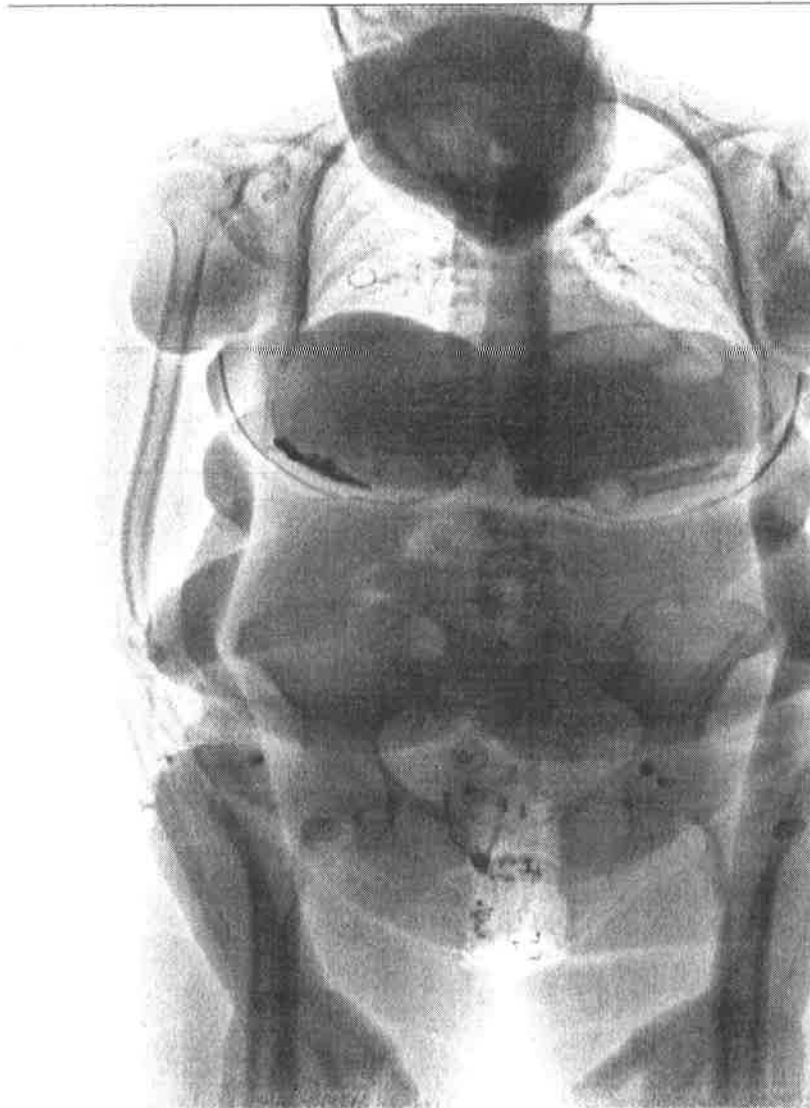
