- 1. Contract Documents This agreement shall consist of this Contract Agreement for On-Line Auction Services, in compliance with all requirements and amendments issued for the NASPO ValuePoint contract 40-000-14-00059AA and Boone County Terms and Conditions. All such documents shall constitute the contract documents which are incorporated herein by reference. Service or product data, specification and literature submitted with proposal response may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office contract file for this contract if not attached. In the event of conflict between any of the foregoing documents, the terms, conditions, provisions and requirements contained in this Agreement shall prevail and control over the Contractor's proposal response.

- 6. The delivery date shall be stated in definite terms.
- 7. The County Commission reserves the right to cancel all or any part of orders if delivery is not made or work is not started as guaranteed. In case of delay, the Contractor must notify the Purchasing Department.
- 8. In case of default by the Contractor, the County of Boone will procure the articles or services from other sources and hold the Contractor responsible for any excess cost occasioned thereby.
- 9. Failure to deliver as guaranteed may disqualify Contractor from future bidding.
- 10. Prices must be as stated in units of quantity specified and must be firm.
- The County of Boone, Missouri expressly denies responsibility for, or ownership of any item purchased until same is delivered to the County and is accepted by the County.
- 12. The County reserves the right to award to one or multiple respondents. The County also reserves the right to not award any item or group of items if the services can be obtained from a state or other governmental entities contract under more favorable terms. The resulting contract will be considered "Non-Exclusive". The County reserves the right to purchase advertising from other vendors.
- 13. The County, from time to time, uses federal grant funds for the procurement of goods and services. Accordingly, the provider of goods and/or services shall comply with federal laws, rules and regulations applicable to the funds used by the County for said procurement, and contract clauses required by the federal government in such circumstances are incorporated herein by reference. Prosecuting Attorney:

The Prosecuting Attorney's Office is eligible the "Evidence.com Prosecutor Program". This solution provides any prosecutor who receives shared evidentiary assets from any other Evidence.com ("eCom") agency¹ with the ability to obtain a custom eCom environment, with as many basic user credentials as you need for your entire staff. We will also provide you with 3 pro user credentials (adding additional advanced features) at no cost, as well as 1TB of complimentary direct uploaded evidence which is counted separate from the shared assets from other eCom customers. The proposed number of these licenses is as follows:

License Features:

I have attached a feature tiers guide that explains the difference between the Basic and Pro license tiers. The most significant additional functions within a **pro license** are:

1. Redaction Studio:

- a. Provides for video blur/blackout, object tracker within a video, audio mute, and video highlight.
- b. Also allows for redaction of audio-only files
- c. Photo redaction (blur/blackout)
- d. Document redaction coming soon

¹ Currently, agencies in Boone County that are using eCom for evidence upload are Columbia PD and Mizzou PD. Other agencies have "lite" accounts for managing their TASER electric weapons.

2. Multi-cam playback:

- a. Allows for the simultaneous, time-synced play back of up to 4 videos that were generated by Axon devices (body camera, in-car, drone, etc.)
- b. Third-party multi-cam playback coming soon
- c. Export of multi-cam view coming soon
- 3. Transcription / Fast Evidence Review:
 - a. This is a brand-new feature that creates artificial intelligence-generated text files of the audio portion of a video or audio recording. It couldn't be easier, simply click the "auto transcribe", and the system will get to work creating an auto-generated, hyper-linked transcript of the audio portion of the video. Each pro license comes with 100 starter pack minutes that expire at the end of 2020 (they will then be re-upped for the same 100 minutes per user for 2021). We do not have pricing for prosecutor quite finalized but will have that by the end of September.
 - b. Your account would have 3 Pro license users, so those 100 per user minutes will pool for your entire office and you'll have the ability to auto-transcribe up to 300 minutes of video/audio without the need to procure additional minutes (we're looking at pricing both a la carte and unlimited plans, but I don't have a solid figure on those costs yet).

Additional Storage Options:

In order to receive or upload evidence directly into the DA's eCom account (from non-Axon agencies or from the public), those files can be uploaded either through the web interface or by using either Axon Citizen or Axon Upload XT. A storage plan is necessary to cover the storage of those direct-upload assets. I would recommend that you consider a phased plan of 5TB/year and expanding over time. I wouldn't recommend looking more than 5 years out as the cost of storage may change and you would want to have the most beneficial pricing. These storage amounts can be adjusted based upon your needs, but based on other similar-sized offices' needs, I recommend the following:

Year 1:	5TB	\$2,400.00
Year 2:	10TB	\$4,800.00
Year 3:	20TB	\$9,600.00
Year 4:	20TB	\$9,600.00
Year 5:	20TB	\$9,600.00

This direct upload into the DA's account can facilitate the acceptance of assets from non-Axon agencies as well as from citizens or private entities. These amounts can be modified based on your needs.

File Conversion:

Evidence.com does not support (yet) live conversion of video files, however, it is possible to store, share, and manage non-compliant formats within evidence.com, as the system is file type agnostic. The files would need to be downloaded with the associated player in order to effectuate playback. An add-on file conversion service is coming in early 2021.

Axon does offer a channel service that will allow for either a one-time bulk migration of data (to include conversion of many proprietary video formats to .mp4 by way of a proxy while still retaining the original asset), or creation of an active channel if you have a consistent large influx of proprietary video formats.

Please note that there are several law enforcement-specific proprietary formats that we cannot convert due to intellectual property restrictions (Panasonic *Arbitrator* being the most common).

Discovery:

Evidence.com allows for several mechanisms of providing discovery.

1. Download links [Free]:

This is the primary means for providing external discovery and disclosure within Evidence.com. It does
not require a recipient to sign in or to enter into a contractual relationship with Axon. It is, however,
highly dependent on the bandwidth available for download, which can become burdensome.
Additionally, the recipient will need to manage and store that data on their own local desktop or
servers, which also creates a burden and associated cost.

2. Access management [Free]:

- Within Evidence.com, an originating agency can provide external parties with an access link that allows the recipient to view the relevant video while still remaining on the original account. This allows the recipient to view at their convenience while only using a limited amount of bandwidth (streaming bandwidth is significantly less than download or upload bandwidth). This is done through a guest user portal called "My.Evidence.com"
 - My.evidence.com is a free portal that anyone can register an individual account with.
 - Police and/or prosecuting agencies can share files with these accounts, and defense can log in to stream
 the videos instead of downloading them. Downloading is still available but can be done only when
 needed.
- This option is not used frequently, as it requires a comfort level between both agencies that does not always exist, due to the following:
 - 1. The originating agency will be able to see which users have logged in, how often they log in, how often they view a file, and any notes they take on the file. As you can imagine, this could create some concerns with attorney/client privilege.
 - 2. The recipient will be able to see any work product or other potentially confidential information that the originating agency has added to the file.
 - 3. Recipient would not have their own copy of the video and their access can be revoked at any time by the originating agency, and your retention/deletion protocols would apply to their access as well.
 - Due to these concerns, my.evidence.com is almost never used for discovery

3. Evidence.com Defender [Paid]:

- A public defender office may purchase their own full-fledged evidence.com domain, just like the one
 police and prosecutor offices manage, for \$15 per basic license per user (per month) and \$39 per pro
 license per user (per month). Storage of shared data is unlimited and free.
- This allows defenders to take their own copies of evidence received through discovery to stream, clip, bookmark, etc. Since their copy becomes separate, their audit trails, notes, and other metadata will remain separate for each piece of evidence andtheir work product will remain safe, privileged, and confidential. This is the same process that law enforcement uses to share files with the prosecutor (Partner Agency Case shares).
