
FINDING OF PUBLIC NUISANCE AND ORDER FOR ABATEMENT

Now on this 6 day of September 2022, the County Commission of Boone County, Missouri met in regular session and entered the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and order for abatement of nuisance:

Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law

The County Commission finds as fact and concludes as a matter of law the following:

- 1. The Boone County Code of Health Regulations (the "Code") are officially noticed and are made a part of the record in this proceeding.
- 2. The City of Columbia/Boone County Health Department administrative record is made a part of the record in this proceeding and incorporated herein by reference. In addition, any live testimony of the official(s) of the department and other interested persons are made a part of the record in this proceeding.
- 3. A public nuisance exists described as follows: growth of weeds in excess of twelve inches high on the premises.
- 4. The location of the public nuisance is as follows 121 Moonglow Ln, Columbia, MO, a/k/a parcel# 17-319-12-01-294.00 01, Section 12, Township 48, Range 12 as shown by deed book 3176 page 0122, Boone County
- 5. The specific violation of the Code is: growth of weeds in excess of twelve inches high in violation of section 6.7 of the Code.
- 6. The Health Director's designated Health Official made the above determination of the existence of the public nuisance at the above location. Notice of that determination and the requirement for abatement was given in accordance with section 6.10.1 of the Code on the 18th day of June 2022, to the property owner.
- 7. The above described public nuisance was not abated. As required by section 6.10.2 of the Code, the property owner was given notice of the hearing conducted this date before the Boone County Commission for an order to abate the above nuisance at government expense with the cost and expense thereof to be charged against the above described



property as a special tax bill and added to the real estate taxes for said property for the current year.

8. No credible evidence has been presented at the hearing to demonstrate that no public nuisance exists or that abatement has been performed or is unnecessary; accordingly, in accordance with section 6.10.2 of the Code and section 67.402, RSMo, the County Commission finds and determines from the credible evidence presented that a public nuisance exists at the above location which requires abatement and that the parties responsible for abating such nuisance have failed to do so as required by the Health Director or Official's original order referred to above.

Order For Abatement Chargeable As a Special Assessment To The Property

Based upon the foregoing, the County Commission hereby orders abatement of the above described public nuisance at public expense and the Health Director is hereby authorized and directed to carry out this order.

It is further ordered and directed that the Health Director submit a bill for the cost and expense of abatement to the County Clerk for attachment to this order and that the County Clerk submit a certified copy of this order and such bill to the County Collector for inclusion as a special assessment on the real property tax bill for the above described property for the current year in accordance with section 67.402, RSMo.





Permanent Stormwater Management BMP Security Agreement

Date: July 19, 2022

Developer/Owner Name: <u>D & D</u> Investments of Columbia LLC

This agreement is made by and between the above-named developer (herein "Developer") and Boone County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri, through its Resource Management Department, (herein "County") and shall be effective on the above date when signed and approved by all persons listed below.

In consideration of the performance based by each party of their obligations described in this agreement, the parties agree to the following:

- 1. Background and Purpose of Agreement The Developer is the owner or authorized agent of the owner for the real estate contained within the development described above which is subject to the Boone County Stormwater Regulations and the Boone County Subdivision Regulations. This agreement is made pursuant to Section 1.7.5 in the Subdivision Regulations of Boone County, Missouri in order to permit the Developer to obtain final acceptance of the subdivision final plat for the development described above, and to assure County of final completion of required permanent stormwater management BMP improvements. By entering into this agreement, the developer is agreeing to comply with the Construction Plans described below in accordance with the County Stormwater Regulations and specifications and provide to County financial security in the event the developer fails to comply with the plans, or complete the improvements within the time and manner provided for by this agreement.
- 2. **Description of Improvements** The Developer agrees to complete the following described improvements in accordance with the published Boone County Stormwater Regulations and related specifications contained within the regulations now in effect and the Construction Plans described below:

Construct <u>one (1) Bioretention Basin/Cell located on common lot C1</u> in accordance with the Construction Plans by <u>Crockett Engineering Consultants LLC</u> that were reviewed for compliance and authorized to proceed by Boone County on <u>05/21/2021</u>.

3. **Time for Completion** – The Developer agrees to complete the permanent stormwater management BMP improvements as described above no later than the <u>1st day of November</u> <u>2023</u>, and all such improvements shall pass County inspection as of this date.

- 4. Security for Performance To secure the Developer's performance of its obligations under this agreement, Developer hereby agrees to provide the County with security in the amount of <u>\$33,300.00</u>, which County may use and apply for Completion of the above described improvements in the event the Developer fails to complete the above described improvements within the time or within manner required by County under its regulations. The Security shall be provided to County as a condition precedent to the effectiveness of this agreement in the following form (check one):
 - □ Cash deposit with County Treasurer
 - ☑ Irrevocable standby letter of credit, with form to be approved by County and issued to Treasurer of Boone County, Missouri
 - □ Certificate of Deposit issued by FDIC insured bank for a term of _____ months
 - □ Corporate surety bond issued to Boone County
- 5. Use of Security The Developer hereby authorizes County to use, redeem, or otherwise obtain payment as applicable, from the security described above for purposes of completing improvements required of the Developer under this agreement in the event that such improvements are not completed within the time provided for by this agreement, or any extension thereof granted by County in its discretion, or in the event such improvements are not completed in accordance with regulatory requirements or specifications imposed by County. Developer authorizes County to cash the selected form of security contemplated herein upon written instructions from the duly elected and serving Treasurer of Boone County without further authorization or signature required by Developer. In the event Developer fulfills its obligations in the time and manner required by this agreement and obtains a satisfactory final inspection from the County prior to the Time for Completion date listed in 3 above, then County shall provide Developer with written proof that the requirements of this Security Agreement are satisfied, and the selected form of security in 4 above can be released to Developer. If no written proof has been provided to the financial institution issuing the selected form of security in 4 above that Developer has complied with the requirements of this Agreement, however, then the financial institution shall, on the Time for Completion date listed in 3 above, or such extended period as mutually-agreed by the parties in writing, shall immediately transfer the balance of the selected form of security in 4 above to the account then-designated by the Boone County Treasurer. If the total sum of the selected form of security in 4 above is not used for completion of any necessary permit items, then the remaining balance shall be paid to Developer within thirty (30) days of completion and acceptance of any required work, along with an itemization of charges detailing the expenditures made by the County.
- 6. Additional Sums Due In the event that the security provided herein is insufficient to complete the required improvements as determined by the County, Developer will, upon demand by the County accompanied by a detailed itemization of the requested additional sum, deposit with County such additional monies which, in the opinion of the County, will be required to complete the necessary improvements. In the event that Developer does not deposit the additional monies with the County within ten (10) days, the Developer shall be deemed in default of this Agreement.
- Remedies Cumulative Exercise or waiver by the County of any enforcement action under this Agreement does not waive or foreclose any other or subsequent enforcement action whatsoever. The County shall be entitled to its costs, including reasonable attorneys' fees, in enforcement of Developer's obligations under this Agreement.

- 8. Authority of Representative Signatories Signatories to this agreement who execute this agreement in a representative capacity for a corporation, limited liability company or partnership, or other business entity, hereby affirmatively represent that they have obtained all resolutions or orders needed to enter in this agreement and are duly authorized to enter into this agreement and bind the parties which they represent to all terms and conditions herein.
- 9. **Binding Effect** This agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto in their respective heirs, personal representative, administrators, successors, and interest in successors in assigned offices. The County and Developer hereby accept this Agreement as a lawful and satisfactory Security Agreement.



PURCHASE AGREEMENT for OVERHEAD DOOR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR TERM & SUPPLY

THIS AGREEMENT, # C000476, dated the ______ day of ______ september ______ 2022 is made between Boone County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri through the Boone County Commission, herein "County" and **D.H. Pace Company, Inc.**, herein "Vendor."

IN CONSIDERATION of the parties' performance of the respective obligations contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. Contract Documents - This agreement shall consist of this Purchase Agreement for Overhead Door Maintenance and Repair – Term & Supply in compliance with all bid specifications and any addenda issued for the City of Columbia Contract 102/2022, Boone County Insurance Requirements, and Boone County's Standard Terms and Conditions. All such documents shall constitute the contract documents which are incorporated herein by reference. Service or product data, specification and literature submitted with the bid response may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office bid file for this bid if not attached. In the event of conflict between any of the foregoing documents, this Purchase Agreement, the City of Columbia Contract 102/2022, and Boone County Standard Terms and Conditions shall prevail and control over the vendor's bid response.

2. *Purchase* - The County agrees to purchase from the Vendor and the Vendor agrees to supply the County with Overhead Door Maintenance and Repair services. These services will be provided as required in the bid specifications and in conformity with the contract documents for the prices set forth in the Contractor's bid response, as needed and as ordered by County.

3. *Contract Period* - The contract period shall be August 8, 2022 through August 7, 2023. Contract may be renewed by order of the Cunty for four (4) additional one-year periods. This agreement may be extended beyond the expiration date by order of the County on a month-to-month basis in the event the County is unable to re-bid and/or award a new contract prior to the expiration date.

4. *Purchase Order* – The County may issue a Purchase Order for any order placed from this contract.

5. Pricing -

Prevailing Wage – Prevailing Wage shall apply to each project if applicable as follows:

- If a quote received for a project from this Term and Supply contract for a "major repair" or "construction" of a public work project is \$75,000 or less, then the Prevailing Wage Law will **NOT** apply to that project.
- If a quote received for a project from this Term and Supply contract for a "major repair" or "construction" of a public work project is greater than \$75,000, then the Prevailing Wage Law <u>WILL</u> apply to the entire project.
- **Special Rule for Change Orders**: If the County accepts a quote for less than \$75,000 for a "major repair" or "construction" of a public work project and that project is later subject to a change order that raises the total project price over \$75,000, then the vendor is responsible for identifying that portion of

the work causing charges that are in excess of \$75,000 and the Prevailing Wage Law WILL apply to only that portion of the project that is in excess of \$75,000.

6. *Performance, Labor, and Materials Bonding* – The contractor on a public improvement project costing more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) shall provide to the County, on County forms, a Performance Bond and a Labor and Material Payment Bond, with corporate surety, satisfactory to the purchasing agent, each in an amount not less than the project price.

7. *Billing and Payment* - All billing shall be invoiced to the Boone County ordering department. This is a county-wide contract which may include Boone County Facilities Maintenance and Boone County Road and Bridge. Billings may only include the prices listed herein. No additional fees for paperwork processing, labor, or taxes shall be included as additional charges. The County agrees to pay all invoices within thirty days of receipt. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount; in the event the billing dispute is resolved in favor of the Vendor, the County agrees to pay interest at a rate of 9% per annum on disputed amounts withheld commencing from the last date that payment was due.

8. *Binding Effect* - This agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this agreement remains in full force and effect.

9. *Entire Agreement* – This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior negotiations, written or verbal, and any other bid or bid specification or contractual agreement.
