### Stormwater Erosion and Sediment Control Security Agreement

Date: December 20, 2019

Developer/Owner Name: Fred Overton Development Inc. Address: 2712 Chapel Wood View Columbia, MO 65201

Development: Perche Ridge Plat 1

This agreement is made by and between the above named developer (herein "Developer") and Boone County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri, through its Resource Management Department, (herein "County") and shall be effective on the above date when signed and approved by all persons listed below.

In consideration of the performance based by each party of their respective obligations described in this agreement, the parties agree to the following:

- 1. Background and Purpose of Agreement The Developer is the owner or authorized agent of the owner for the real estate contained within the development described above which is subject to the Boone County Stormwater Regulations. This agreement is made pursuant to Section 8.4 Performance and Guarantee, in the Stormwater Regulations of Boone County, Missouri in order to permit the Developer to disturb land on the development described above, and to assure County of the required erosion and sediment control and stormwater management. By entering into this agreement the developer is agreeing to comply with the erosion and sediment plan described below in accordance with the County Stormwater Regulations and specifications and provide to County financial security in the event the developer fails to comply with the plan, or complete the improvements within the time and manner provided for by this agreement.
- 2. Description of Improvements The Developer agrees to adhere to the Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) and Erosion and Sediment Control (ESC) Plans for Construction activities at Perche Ridge Plat 1. The SWPPP and ESC plan was prepared by Crockett Engineering Consultants on October 18, 2019.
- Time for Completion The Developer agrees to complete the land disturbance activities and stabilize the site as described in the SWPPP no later than the 10<sup>th</sup> day of December 2019, and all such improvements shall pass County inspection as of this date.
- 4. Security for Performance To secure the Developer's performance of its obligations under this agreement, Developer hereby agrees to provide the County with security in the amount of \$136,796.00, which County may use and apply for Completion of the above described improvements in the event the Developer fails to complete the above described improvements within the time or within manner required by County under its regulations. The Security shall be provided to County as a condition precedent to the effectiveness of this agreement in the following form:

- □ Irrevocable standby letter of credit, with form to be approved by County and issued to Treasurer of Boone County, Missouri
- 5. Use of Security The Developer hereby authorizes County to use, redeem, or otherwise obtain payment as applicable, from the security described above for purposes of completing improvements required of the Developer under this agreement in the event that such improvements are not completed within the time provided for by this agreement, or any extension thereof granted by County in its discretion, or in the event such improvements are not completed in accordance with regulatory requirements or specifications imposed by County. Developer authorizes County to cash the Letter of Credit contemplated herein upon written instructions from the duly elected and serving Treasurer of Boone County without further authorization or signature required by Developer. In the event Developer fulfills its obligations in the time and manner required by this agreement and obtains a satisfactory final inspection from the County prior to December 10, 2019, then County shall provide Developer with written proof that the requirements of this Security Agreement are satisfied and the Letter of Credit can be released to Developer. If no written proof has been provided to the financial institution issuing the Letter of Credit that Developer has complied with the requirements of this Agreement, however, then the financial institution shall, on December 10, 2019, or such extended period as mutually-agreed by the parties in writing, shall immediately transfer the balance of the Letter of Credit to the account then-designated by the Boone County Treasurer. If the total sum of the Letter of Credit is not used for completion of any necessary permit items, then the remaining balance shall be paid to Developer within thirty (30) days of completion and acceptance of any required work, along with an itemization of charges detailing the expenditures made by the County.
- 6. Additional Sums Due In the event that the security provided herein is insufficient to complete the required improvements as determined by the County, Developer will, upon demand by the County accompanied by a detailed itemization of the requested additional sum, deposit with County such additional monies which, in the opinion of the County, will be required to complete the necessary improvements. In the event that Developer does not deposit the additional monies with the County within ten (10) days, the Developer shall be deemed in default of this Agreement.
- 7. Remedies Cumulative Exercise or waiver by the County of any enforcement action under this Agreement does not waive or foreclose any other or subsequent enforcement action whatsoever. The County shall be entitled to its costs, including reasonable attorneys' fees, in enforcement of Developer's obligations under this Agreement.
- 8. Authority of Representative Signatories Signatories to this agreement who execute this agreement in a representative capacity for a corporation, limited liability company or partnership, or other business entity, hereby affirmatively represent that they have obtained all resolutions or orders needed to enter in this agreement and are duly authorized to enter into this agreement and bind the parties which they represent to all terms and conditions herein.
- Binding Effect This agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto in their respective heirs, personal representative, administrators, successors, and interest in

successors in assigned offices. The County and Developer hereby accept this Agreement as a lawful and satisfactory Security Agreement.

#### **K-9 MAINTENANCE TRAINING AGREEMENT**

THIS AGREEMENT dated the <u>January</u>, 20<u>23</u>, is entered into by and between Boone County, Missouri (County), by and through the Boone County Sheriff's Office (BCSO), and Clinton County Sheriff's Office (Agency):

WHEREAS, BCSO can provide K-9 maintenance training through its certified K-9 training staff;

and

WHEREAS, Agency desires to send its K-9 and handler through the BCSO's K-9 maintenance training program; and

WHEREAS, County and Agency have the authority to cooperate with each other for the purposes of this Agreement pursuant to RSMo §70.220;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed by and between the parties as follows:

1. MAINTENANCE TRAINING. BCSO agrees to provide Agency's K-9 handler and K-9 maintenance training by and through BCSO's certified staff. Training areas will include obedience, narcotics detection, tracking, building search, area search, article search, K-9 aggression control, and scenario-based training. The training shall consist of not less than twenty (20) sessions. Agency will receive a certificate documenting successful completion of the BCSO's program.

2. EMPLOYED STATUS OF K-9 HANDLER. Agency agrees that the training contemplated herein is within the scope and course of its handler's employment and Agency will be responsible for all appropriate compensation and the provision of Worker's Compensation coverage to Agency's employee. Agency's handler will execute a Waiver & Release as set out in the attached Exhibit "A" prior to being permitted to participate in the training.

**3. CONTRACT PRICE AND PAYMENT.** Agency shall pay County a total sum of One Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$2,000.00) for the training contemplated herein, calculated at a rate of \$100/session. Agency shall pay one-half, or \$1,000.00, upon execution of this contract and the remaining one-half, or \$1,000.00, after ten (10) sessions have been completed.

4. TERM AND TERMINATION. The term of this Agreement shall begin immediately upon execution of the same for a period of one-year, and may be renewed for two (2) additional, one-year contracts on the same terms and conditions as set forth herein. Either party may terminate this Agreement at any time by providing the other written notice of their intent to terminate at least 90 days in advance of the intended termination date. In the event of a termination, the parties will reconcile the payments paid and/or due based on the number of sessions attended and the rate of \$100.00 per session.

5. MODIFICATION AND WAIVER. No modification or waiver of any provision of this Agreement nor consent to any departure therefrom, shall in any event be effective, unless the same shall be in writing and signed by County and Agency and then such modification, waiver or consent shall be effective only in the specific instance and for the specific purpose for which mutually agreed.

6. FUTURE COOPERATION. The parties agree to fully cooperate with each other to give full force and effect to the terms and intent of this Agreement.

7. ENTIRE AGREEMENT. The parties state that this document contains the entire agreement between the parties, and there are no other oral, written, express or implied promises, agreements, representations or inducements not specified herein.

1. **8.** AUTHORITY. The signatories to this Agreement warrant and certify that they have obtained the necessary authority, by resolution or otherwise, to execute this Agreement on behalf of the named party for whom they are signing.

#### LAW ENFORCEMENT ASSET TRANSFER COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, dated this 17th day of January, 2023, is

made and entered into by and between the parties, **Boone County**, **Missouri**, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri, herein **"County"** and the **City of Columbia**, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri, herein "City".

WHEREAS, County has acquired certain law enforcement assets for the operation of the Boone County Sheriff's Office; and

WHEREAS, County and City routinely assist each other's law enforcement efforts for the benefit of the citizens of Columbia and all of Boone County; and

WHEREAS, City is further developing its law enforcement K-9 program; and

WHEREAS, County has available certain surplus equipment for law enforcement

K-9 use; and

WHEREAS, City's law enforcement efforts will benefit from the transfer of these assets from the County to the City for continued law enforcement use; and

WHEREAS, this Cooperative Agreement (hereinafter referred to as "Agreement") memorializes the parties' understanding regarding the transfer of these County assets to the City; and

WHEREAS, RSMo §70.220 authorizes the parties to enter into cooperative agreements for the purposes herein stated.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual covenants and agreements in this Agreement, the parties agree as follows:

- PURPOSE. The purpose of this Agreement is to facilitate the transfer of ownership of certain items of personal property from County to City for law enforcement purposes, to-wit: one (1) Ray-Allen Cruise EZE K-9 Vehicle Insert for 2013-2019 Ford Interceptor Utility (SUV) (Boone County Asset Tag: 20150) and one (1) Radiotronics Ace K9 Vehicle Heat Alarm (Boone County Asset Tag: 20465).
- COUNTY AGREEMENTS. Within thirty (30) days after the final execution of this Agreement, County will transfer all right, title, and interest in the following items of property to City:
  - a. One (1) Ray-Allen Cruise EZE K-9 Vehicle Insert for 2013-2019 Ford Interceptor Utility (SUV) (Boone County Asset Tag: 20150); and
  - b. One (1) Radiotronics Ace K9 Vehicle Heat Alarm (Boone County Asset Tag: 20465).

#### 3. CITY AGREEMENTS.

City will accept the transferred assets on an "as-is" basis and place the same in service for law enforcement purposes for so long as City deems it appropriate.

- 4. **NO WARRANTIES.** The personal property transferred herein is delivered in "asis" condition with no warranties of any kind.
- 5. **ASSIGNMENT.** Neither party may assign or transfer any of its rights or obligations under this Agreement to any other person or entity without the prior, written consent of the other party.

- 6. **SOLE BENEFIT OF PARTIES.** This Agreement is for the sole benefit of the parties to this agreement only, and nothing in this Agreement is intended to confer any rights or remedies on any other party.
- 7. **RELATIONSHIP OF PARTIES.** Nothing in this agreement shall be deemed or construed by the parties, nor by any other party, as creating the relationship of principal and agent, or of partnership, or of joint venture, between the parties to this agreement.
- 8. **GOVERNING LAW AND VENUE.** This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Missouri, and any action relating to the same shall be brought in the Circuit Court of Boone County, Missouri.
- BINDING ON SUCCESSORS. The covenants, agreements, and obligations herein contained shall extend to, bind, and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors and approved assigns.
- 10. **COUNTERPARTS**. This Agreement may be executed by the parties in several counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original instrument.
- 11. **COMPLETE AGREEMENT.** All negotiations, considerations, representations, and understandings between the parties are incorporated herein, shall supersede any prior agreements, and may be modified or altered only in a writing signed by the parties hereto.
- 12. AUTHORITY OF SIGNATORIES. Each of the persons signing this Agreement on behalf of either party represent that he/she has been duly authorized and empowered, by order, ordinance or otherwise, to execute this Agreement and that all necessary action on behalf of said party to effectuate said authorization has been taken and done.
