

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, this 20 _ day of 200 BOONE COUNTY, MISSOURI, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri, through its County Commission, GRANTOR its successors and assigns, whether one or more and whether an individual, individuals, a corporation, or other legal entity (hereinafter "Grantor"), for and in consideration of the sum of One and No/100th Dollars (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant unto UNION ELECTRIC COMPANY d/b/a AMEREN MISSOURI a Missouri corporation, its successors and assigns (hereinafter "Grantee"), a perpetual easement (hereinafter "Easement") with the right, privilege, and authority of Grantee, its agents, contractors, and subcontractors to survey, stake, construct, reconstruct, replace, use, operate, maintain, patrol, test, inspect, protect, repair, relocate, modify, add to the number of, abandon or retire in place, and remove a pipeline or pipelines for the transportation of gas or other substances, consisting of piping, hardware, valves, communication lines, and other appurtenances thereto (hereinafter individually and collectively "Facilities"), together with all rights and privileges for the exercise and enjoyment of the Easement rights and the authority to extend to any other party the right to use, pursuant to the provisions hereof, upon, over, across and under the following described land in Section 29 AND 30, Township 49N, Range 12W, of the 5th Principal Meridian, in BOONE County, State of Missouri, to-wit:

LEGAL DESCRIPTION IS ON THE ATTACHED EXHIBIT "A", "B" & "C"

Grantor also conveys the right of ingress and egress to and over the Easement Area and premises of Grantor adjoining the same, for all purposes herein stated; together with the right to trim, control the growth, cut and remove or cause to be removed at any time and from time to time, by any means, any and all brush, bushes, saplings, trees, roots, undergrowth, rock, overhanging branches, and other obstructions upon, over, and under the surface of said Easement Area and of the premises of Grantor adjoining the same deemed by Grantee to interfere with the exercise and enjoyment of Grantee's rights hereunder or endanger the safety of the Facilities.

Grantee shall be responsible for actual damages (except the trimming, controlling of growth, cutting, and removal of trees and other vegetation) occurring as a result of the Grantee's exercise of the Easement rights hereinabove conveyed and shall reimburse the owner thereof for such loss or damages.

Grantor, for itself, its successors and assigns, does hereby warrant and covenant unto Grantee, (1) that Grantor is the owner of the Easement Area and has the full right and authority to grant this Easement, (2) that Grantee may quietly enjoy the Easement for the purposes herein stated, and (3) that Grantor will not create or permit any building or other obstruction or condition of any kind or character upon Grantor's premises that will interfere with the Grantee's exercise and enjoyment of the Easement rights hereinabove conveyed.

This Easement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Missouri.



DESCRIPTION FOR PERMANENT UTILITY EASEMENT





Purchasing requests approval for awarding contract C000587 which is co-operative contract CC221938006 for Mailing Equipment, Supplies & Maintenance set up by the State of Missouri using the NASPO Valuepoint contract with Pitney Bowes of Stamford, Connecticut. The contract is primarily for maintenance of existing Pitney Bowes mail equipment which is overseen by the Boone County IT Department. Maintenance of Pitney Bowe's equipment must be performed by Pitney Bowes manufacturer certified technicians. The contract includes provisions for the acquisition of new mail room equipment. In this case, the award includes the purchase of a new Letter Opener for the Boone County Collector's Office.

The original contract period will commence April 11, 2023 and extend through May 14, 2024. There are three (3) one-year renewal options available to renew the contract on a year-to-year basis after the original contract period.

This is a Term and Supply contract. Payment will reference the following Department/Object codes:

1194 - General Fund IT Mail Services/71600 - Equipment Leases & Meter Charges;

1194 - General Fund IT Mail Services /60050 - Equipment Service Contract;

2110 - Collector Tax Maintenance Fund Activity/91000 - Office Equipment.

PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR MAILING EQUIPMENT, SUPPLIES, & MAINTENANCE

THIS AGREEMENT, Contract Number C000587, dated the ______ day of ______ 2023 is made between Boone County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri through the Boone County Commission, herein "County" and Pitney Bowes Inc. herein "Contractor." Boone County contract C000587 is established using cooperative contract State of Missouri contract number CC221938006 which uses NASPO Valuepoint cooperative contract Master Agreement CTR058808, (the Master Agreement), and any amendments thereto.

IN CONSIDERATION of the parties' performance of the respective obligations contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. **Contract Documents** - This agreement shall be referred to as the "Purchase Agreement" and shall consist of (1) this Purchase Agreement for **Mailing Equipment, Supplies & Maintenance** and (2) State of Missouri contract **CC221938006**. All terms, conditions, requirements and pricing of the Purchase Agreement shall be in compliance with State of Missouri contract **CC221938006**. Pricing for the contract shall be determined using State of Missouri contract **CC221938006** and specifically include the attached maintenance pricing from Pitney Bowes dated February 23, 2023 for the County's existing mailing equipment included as **Attachment One** and the quote for the new Letter Opener for the Boone County Collector's Office included as **Attachment Two**. In addition, the Purchase Agreement shall incorporate Boone County Missouri Standard Terms and Conditions attached hereto. All such documents shall constitute the contract documents which are incorporated herein by reference. In the event of conflict between any of the foregoing documents, this Purchase Agreement including Attachments One and Two, Boone County Missouri's Standard Terms and Conditions, Boone County's Insurance Requirements, the State of Missouri's contract CC221938006 and NASPO Valuepoint Master Agreement CTR058808, as amended, shall prevail and control over the Vendor's quote response.

2. *Contract Duration* - This agreement shall commence on the **April 11, 2023 and extend through May 14, 2024** subject to the provisions for termination specified below. Three (3) one-year renewal options are available for the County to renew the contract period subsequent to the initial contract period subject to the Master Agreement being extended.

3. *Purchase* - The County agrees to purchase from the Vendor and the Vendor agrees to supply the County with Mailing Equipment, Supplies and Maintenance as described and priced in Attachment One and the new Letter Opener as priced in Attachment Two. In addition, the County upon the Contractor's agreement, has the option to purchase other equipment available under the terms, conditions and pricing of the State of Missouri contract CC221938006. Any such additional order of equipment or service shall be accomplished in writing using a formal amendment to the Purchase Agreement mutually agreed to and signed by the Contractor and the County, as approved by the Boone County Commission.

4. *Delivery* – The contractor agrees to deliver in accordance with the terms of Contract CC221938006 and said Master Agreement.

5. Billing and Payment - All billing shall be invoiced to the County Information Technology (IT) department, or as the ordering County office may otherwise designate, and may only include the pricing consistent with State of Missouri Contract CC221938006 and pricing in Attachment One – "Purchase Agreement/Equipment and Software Maintenance Agreement," and Attachment Two. No additional fees for delivery or extra services not included in State of Missouri Contract CC221938006 or taxes shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in State of Missouri Contract CC221938006 The County agrees to pay all invoices within thirty days of receipt. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount; in the event the billing dispute is resolved in favor of the Contractor,

the County agrees to pay interest at a rate of 9% per annum on disputed amounts withheld commencing from the last date that payment was due.

6. Binding Effect - This agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this agreement remains in full force and effect. This Agreement shall be governed under the laws of the State of Missouri and any action relating hereto shall be brought in the Circuit Court of Boone County, Missouri.

7. Termination - This agreement may be terminated by the County upon thirty days advance written notice for any of the following reasons or under any of the following circumstances:

- a. County may terminate this agreement due to material breach of any term or condition of this agreement, provided that the Vendor has had thirty (30) days to cure the breach, or
- b. County may terminate this agreement if in the opinion of the Boone County Commission if delivery of products is delayed or products delivered are not in conformity with Attachment One, or
- c. If appropriations are not made available and budgeted for any calendar year.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the parties through their duly authorized representatives have executed this agreement on the day and year first above written.
