- 5. *Warranty* "Henderson warrants its products to be free from defects in material or workmanship for a period of 12 months after delivery to the original user or 18 months after the factory invoice, whichever occurs first." The 12-month warranty begins from the date that the product is put into service and includes the travel time and mileage required by the technician.
- 6. *Billing and Payment* All billing shall be invoiced to the Boone County Road & Bridge Department, 5551 Tom Bass Rd., Columbia, MO 65201 and billings may only include the prices listed in the vendor's quote response. No additional fees for paperwork processing, labor, or taxes shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in the Vendor's bid response to the specifications. The County agrees to pay all invoices within thirty days of receipt. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount; in the event, that the billing dispute is resolved in favor of the Vendor, the County agrees to pay interest at a rate of 9% per annum on disputed amounts withheld commencing from the last date that payment was due.
- 7. *Binding Effect* This agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this agreement remains in full force and effect.
- 8. *Termination* This agreement may be terminated by the County upon thirty days advance written notice for any of the following reasons or under any of the following circumstances:
 - **a.** County may terminate this agreement due to material breach of any term or condition of this agreement, or
 - **b.** County may terminate this agreement if in the opinion of the Boone County Commission if delivery of products is delayed or products delivered are not in conformity with bidding specifications or variances authorized by the County, or
 - **c.** Termination for Convenience The County may terminate this Agreement for any reason or for no reason upon sixty (60) days' written notice to the contractor, or
 - d. If appropriations are not made available and budgeted for any calendar year.

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
