RE: Amendment #1 to contract C000551 (bid #28-29JUN22) – Doctor’s Orders: Produce Prescription Program with Columbia Center for Urban Agriculture

Attached for signature is contract amendment #1 to contract C000551 (bid #28-29JUN22) – Doctor’s Orders: Produce Prescription Program with Columbia Center for Urban Agriculture of Columbia, Missouri. This amendment adds a supplemental increase of 16,890 units of Supplemental Food at \$1.41 per 1 token for a not to exceed amount of \$23,814.90.

People with low-income that are at risk or currently have diet-related chronic diseases can receive a six-month “prescription” for fruits and vegetables at the Columbia Farmers Market by visiting the Family Health Center. The goal is to reduce health care use and expenses by increasing fruit and vegetable consumption and food security.

Invoices will be paid from department 2162 – CSF Program Funding, account 71106 - Contracted Services. \$1,147,367.45 is the current fund balance.


- 1) ADD a supplemental funding increase for the following:

- 2) Except as specifically amended hereunder, all other terms, conditions and provisions of the original agreement shall remain in full force and effect.


