# PROCLAMATION RECOGNIZING APRIL 2025 AS SECOND CHANCE MONTH

Whereas, every person is endowed with human dignity and value, and redemption and second chances are American values; and

Whereas, in Missouri, the Council of State Governments' Justice Center's National Inventory of Collateral Consequences of Conviction (NICCC) identifies 707 legal provisions that impose collateral consequences, state and federal statutes and regulations that limit or prohibit people convicted of crimes from accessing various rights, benefits, and opportunities; and

Whereas, in light of these collateral consequences, formerly incarcerated individuals often face difficulties when re-entering society, such as finding adequate employment, housing, and education, as well as volunteer opportunities and pathways to pay off debt arising from conviction and incarceration, which are all factors that result in lost potential, contribute to recidivism, and affect public safety; and

Whereas, the safe and successful reentry of justice-involved individuals while balancing the protection and support of victims and survivors is a priority for Boone County; and

Whereas, Second Chance Month, established in recognition of the Second Chance Act of 2007, is an opportunity to reaffirm the importance of helping people who were formerly incarcerated reenter society by addressing both the root causes of crime and the underlying needs of returning citizens through the use of resources devoted to prevention, diversion, reentry, trauma-informed care, culturally-specific services, and social support; and

Whereas, investing in rehabilitation for currently and formerly incarcerated individuals who have worked to make amends and positive contributions in their communities helps reduce crime, prevent violence, and keep children, families, and communities safe by ensuring individuals have the tools, resources, and opportunities to be successful, while helping to bolster the economy and workforce.

Therefore, we, the Boone County Commission, do hereby proclaim April 2025 as Second Chance Month in the County of Boone, Missouri, recognizing it as an opportunity to increase awareness of the value of second chances and the importance of providing the appropriate support to make those second chances successful.
