

Recommendation for Final Design Contract

King Road Bridge Over Sugar Creek Replacement Project BR#0130002

King Road is a dead-end gravel road with access to State Route F in northwestern Boone County. The existing bridge over Sugar Creek is a one-lane, wooden deck and steel beam structure that was constructed in 1925. The bridge is load restricted to 5 tons and it is on the MoDOT poor bridge listing which currently qualifies it for Soft Match Credit. It also has poor alignment with both the creek and the road. The bridge provides access to a 60 acre parcel and a 158 parcel. The owner of the 158 acre parcel has indicated he plans to build a single-family home for himself and possibly another home for his son in the near future.

Boone County hired Midwest Engineering Group, LLC in March 2025 to complete a Preliminary Engineering Study for the removal and replacement of the King Road bridge. The study evaluated four conventional bridge options with estimated construction costs ranging from \$600,000 to \$770,000 and a low-water bridge option estimated at \$540,000.

The low-water bridge, Option 4, is the least expensive, but it will be frequently overtopped and will likely require frequent maintenance to remove sediment and debris that collects on and under the bridge deck. Conventional bridge Option 5 is the second most expensive at \$740,000 but it corrects the poor alignment with the creek and the road, and the bridge deck elevation will be set at or above the 25-year storm recurrence interval to reduce long-term maintenance costs.

Our recommendation is to approve the proposed Midwest Engineering Group, LLC final design contract for the conventional bridge Option 5.



Purchasing requests approval for the award of contract C000991 from contract 15-20 established by the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office as a cooperative contract for the purchase of Telecommunications Maintenance and Related Services (Two-Way Radio System), 800MHz Enhanced Digital Simulcast Systems and 700 MHz Digital P25 Communications System for the Boone County Joint Communications Department with Communications International, Inc. of Tampa, Florida.

The purchase of the 800MHz Enhanced Digital Simulcast Systems and 700 MHz Digital P25 Communications Systems upgrades the current countywide analog radio system to the 800 MHz P25 Phase II trunking public safety radio system. It will establish a modern, interoperable public safety radio system with increased capacity, redundancy, encryption, and signal coverage with room for future expansion.

The contract period will run September 01, 2025 through January 24, 2026. There are five (5) additional two-year renewals option available.

The systems are purchased in phases. The total price for the systems upgrade is \$6,985,438.39. Payments will reference this coding: 2706 – Boone County Joint Communications Radio Improvements/91900 - Boone County Joint Communications Radio Improvements Construction in Progress.

# PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR TELECOMMUNICATIONS MAINTENANCE AND RELATED SERVICES (TWO WAY RADIO SYSTEM) - TERM & SUPPLY

(800 MHz Radio Implementation and Other Implementation Services for Boone County)

THIS AGREEMENT COUNTY CONTRACT C000991, (the "Agreement") is made this day of \_\_September. 2025 (the "Effective Date") between Boone County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri through the Boone County Commission, herein "County" and Communications International, Inc. herein "Contractor."

WHEREAS, the Contractor entered into Contract 15-20 dated December 21, 2020 with Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office, a political subdivision of the State of Florida ("HCSO"), for goods procured pursuant to F.S. §287.057 in response to HCSO's Invitation to Bid 15-20 (the "HCSO Contract") and specifically described as: 800 MHz Enhanced Digital Simulcast Systems and 700 MHz Digital P25 Communications Systems; and

WHEREAS, the County, has the legal authority to "piggyback" onto a contract of another governmental entity when seeking to utilize the same or similar goods and services provided for in the said contract; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to "piggyback" onto the above referenced HSCO Contract between the Contractor and HCSO for the purchase of the same goods and services described in the Contract and the Contractor consents to the aforesaid "piggybacking"

NOW THEREFORE, having found it to be in the public interest, and inconsideration of the parties' performance of the respective obligations contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Contract Documents This Agreement shall consist of this Purchase Agreement for a contract for the furnishing of Telecommunications Maintenance and Related Services (800 MHz Radio Implementation and Other Implementation Services for Boone County), in compliance with all bid specifications and any addenda issued for Hillsborough County Sheriff's Association bid/contract number 15-20, Boone County Insurance Requirements as well as Boone County's Standard Terms and Conditions and including Communications International proposal for Boone County for the P25 Public Safety Radio System for Boone County Joint Communications dated July 2025, the e-mail dated August 5, 2025 including the Warranty Response Time Commitment, and the e-mail dated August 7, 2025 including the Warranty and Maintenance Plan, submitted by Wayne Farro on behalf of the Contractor, the Bonne County P25 Radio System Implementation Preliminary Scope of Work (the "SOW"); the Boone Project Timeline ("Project Schedule"). All such documents are incorporated into this Agreement as Attachment One by reference and shall collectively constitute the "Contract Documents". Service or product data, specifications and literature submitted with the bid response may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office contract file for this contract if not attached.
- 2. Contract Period The contract period shall be September 01, 2025 through January 24, 2026. The contract may be renewed for five (5) additional two (2)-year periods subsequent to this initial term at the County's sole option and subject to the Hillsborough County Sheriffs Association renewing the cooperative contract. Notwithstanding that the HCSO Contract may terminate prior to the expiration of an individual order or System completion under this Agreement it is expressly agreed that any order issued pursuant to

this Agreement shall continue to be in full force and effect until the System's completion or the expiration of such order's stated minimum term, if any.

- 3. Purchase The County agrees to purchase from the Contractor and the Contractor agrees to supply the County with the Project 25 Public Safety Radio System, P25 Trunked Simulcast Radio Network that includes the 8-site system design and coverage analysis; all proposed equipment, hardware, software, supplies and materials including installation and system testing; training and on-going support; system maintenance and warranty coverage for three (3) years all as detailed in Attachment One for the firm price of \$6,985,438.39 (the "Total System Price").
- 4. Governing Law The parties hereto agree that the laws of the State of Missouri shall govern this contract. Any litigation involving this Agreement shall be filed in the Circuit Court of Boone County, Missouri.
- 5. Billing and Payment All billing shall be invoiced to the Boone County Joint Communications Department located at 2145 County Drive, Columbia, Missouri, 65202. Billings may only include the prices listed in the Contractor's proposal response. No additional fees for delivery or extra services or taxes shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in the Contractor's proposal response to the specifications. The County agrees to pay all correct invoices within thirty (30) calendar days of receipt; the Contractor agrees to honor any cash or prompt payment discounts offered in its proposal response if the County makes payment as provided therein. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount; in the event the billing dispute is resolved in favor of the Contractor, the County agrees to pay interest at a rate of 9% per annum on disputed amounts withheld commencing from the last date that payment was due.
- 6. Binding Effect This agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this agreement remains in full force and effect.
- 7. Order Of Precedence In the event of any conflict or inconsistency between any Contract Documents, the Contract Documents shall be given precedence in the following order:
  - (a) the main body of this Purchase Agreement and any mutually agreed upon changes thereto;
  - (b) the Systems Addendum;
  - (c) the HCSO Contract 15-20, including the specifications and any addenda issued by HCSO to Contractor in response to its IFB number 15-20, as such has been amended, modified, and supplemented by the documents set forth in "d" below specifically for Boone's County's System;
  - (d) Communications International proposal for Boone County for the P25 Public Safety Radio System for Boone County Joint Communications dated July 2025, the e-mail dated August 5, 2025 including the Warranty Response Time Commitment, and the e-mail dated August 7, 2025 including the Warranty and Maintenance Plan.
- 8. Entire Agreement This Purchase Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior negotiations, written or verbal, and any other proposal or proposal specification or contractual agreement. This agreement may only be amended in writing by the Boone County Purchasing Office as approved by the Boone County Commission using the same formality as this agreement.
- 9. Termination This agreement may be terminated by the County upon thirty (30) calendar days advance written notice for any of the following reasons or under any of the following circumstances:

- (a) Either party may terminate this agreement upon notice to the other party of material breach and if such breaching party fails to cure the breach within thirty (30)) days after receiving notice, or
- (b) The County may terminate this agreement if in the opinion of the Boone County Commission if delivery of products is delayed or products delivered are not in conformity with bidding specifications or variances authorized by the County, or
- (c) Termination for Convenience. This agreement may be terminated without cause by either party upon sixty (60) calendar days written notice by certified mail to the other of intent to terminate. Upon termination by either party, the Contractor shall cease work and shall deliver to the County all documents (including reports, designs, specifications, and all other data) prepared or obtained by the Contractor in connection with its services. All finished or unfinished documents, data, studies, surveys, drawings, maps, models, photographs, and reports, prepared by Contractor shall become the property of County and shall be delivered by Contractor to County immediately upon the payment of the Contractor's invoice. Contractor shall accept as full payment for its services, fees for all tasks completed in accordance with the Statement of Work as well as expenses incurred or obligated to be paid for by Contractor prior to receipt of the notice to terminate, or
- The County agrees to utilize their best efforts to assure funding for the continuance of this Agreement; however, if fiscal funding is no longer available, County, upon receipt of notice that sufficient funds are not available to continue its full and faithful performance under this Agreement, will provide prompt, written notice to Contractor of such event and effective thirty (30) days after the giving of such notice, or upon the expiration of the period of time for which funds were appropriated, whichever occurs first, may terminate this Agreement. In such event, County shall within sixty (60) days thereafter return to Ci, at County's expense, each unit(s) of the equipment so affected as follows: (i) Customer shall deliver unencumbered title of the equipment to Contractor and (ii) the equipment returned shall be in good condition, reasonable wear and tear excepted. For purposes of this section, the term "best efforts to assure funding" shall mean that the County has included in its proposed budget sufficient funds to continue its full and faithful performance under this Agreement and that in denying funding, no funds have been approved for replacement, substitute or competitive services or equipment of the type being supplied by Contractor under this Agreement. However, if during such sixty (60) day period County arranges to transfer its duties and obligations to Contractor under this Agreement to another agency in the State or local governmental agency in the State capable of demonstrating the capacity to continue this Agreement, County's obligations as set forth herein shall cease upon the successor agency's written acceptance of the terms hereof. Contractor shall not be liable for any costs or expenses resulting from such transfer of duties and obligations. Thereafter, the successor agency shall be responsible for performing all the obligations of County described in this Agreement. Provided further, in the event of any termination for failure of appropriations, Contractor shall continue to fully perform its maintenance and service obligations under this Agreement only so long as the County continues to pay amounts due hereunder.
- 10. Execution in Counterparts and by Electronic Delivery. This Agreement may be executed in several counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original, and all of which together shall be deemed to be one and the same instrument. Signed counterparts of this Agreement may be delivered by facsimile and by scanned .pdf image and an executed copy of this Agreement received by way of facsimile or by scanned .pdf image shall be deemed to be an original enforceable and admissible for all purposes as may be necessary under the terms hereof.
