Based on information received by our office, it is our understanding that your office received a declaration of candidacy for the August 3, 2010 election from the following candidate:

Bondi Wood

On April 28, 2010, the Missouri Ethics Commission determined that the candidate listed above failed to file a financial interest statement by the twenty-first day after the last day for filing for the August 3, 2010 election. Accordingly, the Missouri Ethics Commission hereby notifies you that the individual listed above is disqualified pursuant to Section 105.492.2, RSMo.

Please note that Section 105.492.2, RSMo. provides:

"If a candidate for office does not file a financial interest statement by the close of business on the twenty-first day after the last day for filing for election for which the person is a candidate, the commission shall notify the official who accepted such candidate's declaration of candidacy that the candidate is disqualified. Such election official shall remove the candidate's name from the ballot."

RE: Disqualification of candidacy pursuant RSMo §105.492

Dear Ms. Wood:

I regretfully write this letter to you on behalf of the Boone County Clerk, Wendy Noren, to inform you that we have received notification from the Missouri Ethics Commission in a letter dated April 28, 2010, received April 29, 2010. A copy of that letter is enclosed.

Wendy Noren, in her capacity as the Boone County Clerk, is the election official who accepted your filing for candidacy. Under applicable Missouri law, specifically RSMo §105.492, the election official "shall" remove the candidate's name from the ballot. No discretion is afforded the election official after notification from the Missouri Ethics Commission and, as a result, Ms. Noren must direct her staff to remove your name from the August 3, 2010 ballot. I enclose a copy of RSMo §105.492.

I can assure you that Ms. Noren, as the local election official, strongly believes in ballot access to all candidates for elections to every sort of public office. Missouri law is very clear on what her duties and obligations are in this matter, however, and she must perform those obligations consistent with the clear directives of Missouri law.

I will make myself available to discuss this matter further with you or your representatives if you wish to do so.

- It is required pursuant to §105.483 to §105.492 RSMo.

**\* If Candidate is required to file, please inform them of the following deadlines/penalties.**

- ✓ If you do not file a PFD/Financial Interest Statement by April 13, 2010, (enter date which is 14 days after filing closing date), you may be assessed a minimum **\$10 per day late fee** for each day the report is late.
- ✓ If your PFD/Financial Interest Statement isn't filed by April 20, 2010 (enter date which is 21 days after filing closing date) you may be **disqualified as a candidate** and your name may be removed from the ballot.

You may also download the Personal Financial Disclosure Statement from the Missouri Ethics Commission website at [www.mec.mo.gov](http://www.mec.mo.gov). Personal Financial Disclosure Statements filed by mail must be postmarked not later than midnight of the day prior to the report deadline to be considered timely filed. Reports hand delivered on the deadline must be received by 5:00 p.m. to be considered timely. Section 105.487 (4) RSMo.

## CAMPAIGN MATERIALS IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

**Governing Statutes:** Section 130.031, RSMo.

**PRINTED MATTER:** Pamphlets, circulars, handbills, sample ballots, advertisements (including in newspapers/periodicals), signs (included those for display on vehicles), or other imprinted or lettered materials. *Items excluded as printed matter include items used for personal use given away or sold, (i.e. campaign buttons, pencils, or clothing) which is paid for by a candidate or committee.*

Who Paid For The Printed Matter	Required Sponsor Information (following the words 'Paid for by')
Candidate from personal funds (only if no candidate committee exists)	First name & last name by which candidate is known
Committee	Committee name as required to be registered by Missouri campaign finance law, & committee treasurer's name and title (serving when the material was paid for)
Corporation, Business Entity, Labor Org., Other Org., Political Committee or organization for influencing election(s)	Name of the entity, entity's principal officer's name, street, city and mailing address of entity or principal officer (if entity has no mailing address)
Individual(s)	Individual(s) name, & mailing address(es). If more than 5 may print "for a list of sponsors contact (name & address of one individual responsible for having material printed)". This individual must keep the names and amounts paid by all other individuals.
Must use full legal name of person and/or entity can include abbreviations or acronyms.	

**TV & RADIO:** If you are a broadcast station transmitting matter about a candidate or ballot measure, you must provide sponsor identification in accordance with federal campaign laws.

**FEDERAL CAMPAIGN LAWS:** If you are a person causing matter to be printed or broadcast about federal candidates, you must provide sponsor identification in accordance with federal campaign laws.

## CANDIDATE/CAMPAIGN FINANCE CHECKLIST

  - 9. Continuously file required Campaign Finance reports
- If unsuccessful:
- ✓ If more money on hand than debt; must terminate committee within 30 days
  - ✓ If more debt than money on hand; can form Debt Service Committee
- If successful:
- ✓ Update election information for committee before accepting future contributions or terminate committee

\* Can be done prior to steps 1 through 5 above.
