BOONE COUNTY FAMILY RESOURCES BOARD

Eight-member Board and one County Commissioner authorized under Chapter 205 RSMo. Meetings are typically held the second Wednesday of the month, at the Boone County Family Resources (BCFR) office at 1209 E. Walnut at 5:30 p.m. The Board provides services to persons with developmental disabilities within Boone County. Members of this board also serve on the Board of Life and Work Connections, Inc., a Section 501(c)(3) corporation that provides vocational services to young adults through a contractual agreement with BCFR. Persons interested in applying for membership on the BCFR Board must complete the more detailed board application form available on the County website or at the Commission Office. **(Term – 3 years) One Vacancy:** term expires 12/31/2021 or 3 years from appointment.

BOONE COUNTY PLANNING & ZONING COMMISSION

Ten-member Board to include one citizen from an unincorporated area of each Township in Boone County and the County Engineer. The Board meets the second Thursday of each month at 5:30PM for a work session and the third Thursday of each month at 7:00PM for a regular session. Special meetings may be called as needed. All meetings are held in the Roger B Wilson Boone County Government Center Chambers. The board advises the County Commission on matters of land use. **(Term – 4 years) One Vacancy:** Bourbon Township term expiring 9/30/2022, or 4 years from appointment.

SENIOR CITIZENS SERVICES CORP

Board members attend monthly board meetings held on the last Wednesday of every month at 3:00 p.m. at The Bluffs. Each of the seven volunteer members also serve on one of four committees (Finance, Human Resources, Quality Assurance, and Planning & Development). The Finance Committee meets monthly at 2:00 p.m. prior to the Board meeting. The other three committees meet on an as needed basis. Board members provide direction and oversight to the administrator of the facility via mission statement and long-term planning/vision. **(Term - 3 years) One Vacancy:** term expires 3/31/2021 or 3 years from appointment.
